

**Important Information**

**The Athletic Commission has established the following guidelines for basketball, volleyball and cheerleading effective with the 96-97 sports season:**

1. Teams having more than 15 players will be split into two teams.
2. For grades 4, 5, and 6, teams will be divided equally. For grades 7 and 8, teams will be divided into "A" and "B" teams.
3. For grades 4, 5, and 6 basketball teams, the minimum playing time will be one quarter. For grades 5 and 6 volleyball teams, each player will participate in a match.
4. For grades 7 and 8 basketball and volleyball teams, there will be no minimum playing time. Teams will play competitively.
5. Beginning with the 97-98 sports season, only those children that played on a 7th grade team (during the previous sports season) will be eligible to register to play on the 8th grade team for the following year. (Exception approved 4/97: does not include children participating in the cheerleading program). Transfer students who have participated in the sport on the seventh grade level at their previous school, will be eligible to register.
