

From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners,

Last Friday, July 4th, our nation celebrated a "new birth of freedom". I could not help but be reminded that William Carol, the brother of the future Bishop John Carol of Baltimore was the only Catholic

signer of this incredibly historical document. Fr John Carol, who was in Boston at the time was on a very prophetic mission. As you may remember, Massachusetts held fast to the Puritan religion. Puritans, it should be noted, were not just the folks with the black hats and buckles of the "first Thanksgiving Day", they were the disciples of Oliver Cromwell, the English revolutionary who had the Anglican, King Charles I executed. Charles I respected and honored his Catholic wife, Henrietta, and tried to maintain his Kingdom with religious liberties for both his Anglican and Catholic subjects.

These Puritans were not just known for their disdain for beer and dancing, but for their violent treatment of Catholics. Fr Carol's mission was to convince the Catholics living in New England that the Declaration of Independence was a good idea. Massachusetts' Catholics rightly feared that if Massachusetts' Puritans were given religious freedom, bad things will follow. Actually, bad things would follow, which is why many Catholics moved to Louisiana.

By 1776, under King George III, the Church of England was well established. This was in the wake of incredible Catholic persecutions, Queen Elizabeth (the "virgin" Queen) alone, had (at least) 220 notable Catholics executed. So now comes the main point of my history lesson: Amid that difficult time, the two Carols had the wisdom to see that America was on the road to building a society with a better sense of religious freedom than what was the experience of the vast majority of people up to that time. The American "experiment" had begun. At the heart of the "experiment" was the desire to see persecution primarily between Catholics and Protestants ended. This new sense of freedom was just as much a warning to Catholics as it was to Protestants. Truth be told, King Charles IX of France of that era had to be scolded by his mother, Queen Catherine, for his executions of Protestants.

But on this wonderful celebration of our Nation's birth, an old but new lesson is desperately needed. We should pray fervently that a new era of a partnership between civil and religious authorities be nurtured. What we call "Western Civilization" would never have come about if civil leaders had not partnered with Catholic religious leaders. St Boniface would never have the success he had with the Germanic pagans if Emperor Charles "the Hammer" had not backed him up. Not too long ago, we saw the benefits when President Reagan partnered with Pope Joh Paul II. What blessings would the world see if today Pope Leo and President Trump took on a partnership of mutual respect and cooperation?

A Note From Cardinal Blase Cupich

The Church teaches that receiving Holy Communion is not a private action but a communal one, as the very word "communion" implies. For that reason, the norm established by the Holy See for the universal Church and approved by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops is for the faithful to process together as an expression of their coming forward as the Body of Christ and to receive Holy

Communion standing. Processions are an ancient practice of the Church and have been part of the liturgy from the earliest days, assisting the faithful to always keep in mind that we are a pilgrim people, making our way together to the fulness of the heavenly banquet Christ has prepared for us. We process into the church. We process up to bring the gifts. We process to receive Holy Communion. We process out to carry the Lord into the world.

Nothing should be done to impede this sacred ritual of receiving communion or diminish its powerful symbol by disrupting an important moment by which the faithful, in processing together, express their faith that they are called to become the very Body of Christ they receive. Certainly, reverence can and should be expressed by bowing before the reception of Holy Communion, but no one should engage in a gesture that calls attention to oneself or disrupts the flow of the procession by assuming another posture. That would be contrary to the norms and tradition of the church, which all the faithful are urged to respect and observe.

Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie,

W zeszły piątek, 4 lipca, świętowaliśmy "koleljne narodziny wolności". Muszę przy tej okazji wspomnieć, że William Carroll, brat przyszłego biskupa Johna Carrolla z Baltimore, był jedynym

katolikiem, który podpisał niezwykle historyczny dokument. Wtedy to właśnie, ks. John Carroll przebywał w Bostonie pełniąc bardzo proroczą misję. Należy wspomnieć, że w tamtych czasach (XVI wiek) Massachusetts mocno trzymało się religii purytańskiej. Natomiast, Purytanie to nie tylko ci ludzie z czarnymi kapeluszami i klamrami znani z "pierwszego Święta Dziękczynienia", ale byli to rónież uczniowie Olivera Cromwella — angielskiego rewolucjonisty, który kazał stracić anglikańskiego króla Karola I. Karol I szanował i kochał swoją katolicką żonę Henriettę i próbował utrzymać swoje królestwo, zapewniając wolność religijną zarówno anglikanom, jak i katolikom.

Natomiast Purytanie słynęli nie tylko z pogardy dla piwa i tańców, ale także z brutalnego traktowania katolików. Misją ojca Carrolla było przekonanie katolików mieszkających w Nowej Anglii, że Deklaracja Niepodległości to dobry pomysł. Katolicy w Massachusetts mieli uzasadnione obawy, że jeśli Purytanie z tego stanu otrzymają wolność religijną, mogą z tego wyniknąć złe rzeczy. I faktycznie, złe rzeczy się wydarzyły co spowodowało, że wielu katolików przeprowadziło się do Luizjany.

W roku 1776, za panowania króla Jerzego III, Kościół anglikański był już dobrze ugruntowany. Miało to miejsce w cieniu brutalnych prześladowań katolików gdzie sama królowa Elżbieta I (nazywana "królową dziewicą") kazała stracić co najmniej 220 znanych katolików. I tu właśnie dochodzimy do sedna mojej lekcji historii. W tych trudnych czasach bracia Carroll wykazali się mądrością, widząc, że Ameryka zmierza w kierunku budowy społeczeństwa o lepszym rozumieniu wolności religijnej, niż to, którego doświadczała zdecydowana większość ludzi w tamtej epoce. Amerykański "eksperyment" został rozpoczęty. U podstaw tego eksperymentu leżało pragnienie zakończenia prześladowań, szczególnie pomiędzy katolikami a protestantami. To nowe pojmowanie wolności było przestrogą zarówno dla katolików, jak i protestantów. Prawda jest taka, że król Karol IX z Francji w tamtych czasach musiał być napominany przez swoją matkę, królową Katarzynę, za egzekucje protestantów.

Obchodząc to wspaniałe święto Niepodległości potrzebna jest stara, lecz wciąż aktualna lekcja. Módlmy się gorliwie, by nastała nowa era współpracy między władzami cywilnymi a duchownymi. To, co nazywamy "cywilizacją Zachodu", nigdy by nie powstało, gdyby przywódcy świeccy nie współdziałali z katolickimi liderami duchowymi. Święty Bonifacy nigdy nie odniósłby sukcesu w nawracaniu germańskich pogan, gdyby nie wsparcie cesarza Karola "Młota". Jeszcze nie tak dawno widzieliśmy owoce współpracy, gdy prezydent Ronald Reagan współdziałał z papieżem św. Janem Pawłem II. Zastanówmy się jakie błogosławieństwa mógłby dziś przynieść światu sojusz pełen szacunku i współpracy między papieżem Leonem a prezydentem Trumpem?


