Dear Parishioners,

Christ in His teachings used various examples and parables. Today's Gospel illustrates how Christ used the ordinary, everyday events to teach basic principles of Christian life.

Today, we look at the hospitality of Lazarus and his sisters Mary and Martha. Mary sat "beside the Lord at His feet listening to Him speak" (Lk 10,39). Martha "was distracted with various servings" (Lk 10, 40), that is, she tried to satisfy the Master and His disciples.

Martha and Mary are two different personalities. Martha represents diligence, care. In contrast, Mary demonstrates concentration, sensitivity to the Word of God, quiet conversation with God. What attitude does Christ take for them? Jesus does not rebuke Martha for preparing a meal; He only pays higher attention to the more important things that should not be forgotten. A meal for the body is necessary, but man also needs bread, which is God and His Word. We always need people, like Mary, who can, "sit at the feet of the Lord," listen to His word and practice it lively. Actually, this is a task for all of us. Each of us must be able and willing to meditate and pray, listen to God's instruction and go to work with Him.

When we reflect about our life and the world around us, we notice more the image of Martha than Mary. We are suffering from worries, activities, running and earning; there is too much care for materialistic things and lack thereof for God, for His word, for prayer. We excuse ourselves for being too busy because of our daily errands and obligations. Martha was also busy, but Mary found time for prayer.

The Christian should be like Martha and Mary. Work does not release us from listening to God's word and prayer, and prayer does not give us the right to neglect our work. Living in

continuous contact with God gives us the opportunity to be the best worker.



Drodzy Parafianie,

Chrystus w swoim nauczaniu posługiwał się różnymi przykładami, przypowieściami. Dzisiejsza Ewangelia jest przykładem tego jak Chrystus wykorzystywał także najzwyklejsze wydarzenia życia

codziennego do pouczania o podstawowych zasadach życia chrześcijańskiego. Dziś patrzymy na gościnę w domu Łazarza i jego sióstr Marii i Marty. Maria siadła "u nóg Pana i przysłuchiwała się Jego mowie" (Łk 10, 39). Marta "uwijała się koło rozmaitych posług" (Łk 10, 40), czyli starała się jak najlepiej ugościć Mistrza i Jego uczniów.

Marta i Maria to dwie osobowości. Marta reprezentuje pracowitość, troskliwość. Maria natomiast skupienie, wrażliwość na Słowo Boże, cichą rozmowę z Bogiem. Jaką postawę wobec nich zajmuje Chrystus? Pan Jezus nie karci Marty za to, że przygotowuje posiłek, zwraca jej tylko uwagę na rzeczy ważniejsze, o których nie należy zapominać. Posiłek dla ciała jest konieczny, ale człowiek potrzebuje także chleba, którym jest Bóg i Jego Słowo. Zawsze potrzebujemy ludzi, którzy potrafią jak Maria "usiąść u stóp Pana", posłuchać Jego słowa i wprowadzić je w życie. Właściwie jest to zadanie dla nas wszystkich. Każdy z nas musi umieć i chcieć rozmyślać i modlić się, wysłuchać Bożego pouczenia i z nim udać się do własnej pracy.

Kiedy tak popatrzymy na siebie i na otaczający nas świat to zauważamy więcej Mart niż Marii. Chorujemy od trosk, zajęć, biegania i zapracowania; zbyt wiele jest troski o chleb, a za mało o Boga, o Jego słowo, o modlitwę. Tłumaczymy się, że nie mamy czasu. Marta też była zabiegana, a Maria znalazła czas na modlitwę.

Chrześcijanin powinien być Martą i Marią. Praca nie zwalnia nas od słuchania słowa Bożego i od modlitwy, a modlitwa nie daje nam prawa do zaniedbywania pracy. Człowiek żyjący w stałym kontakcie z Bogiem jest najlepszym pracownikiem.







When we practice some type of penance on Fridays, we are reminded of the deeper meaning of our lives. The most beautiful gift we have received is God's sacrificial death out of love for us to atone for our sins. Friday is a day to experience more deeply the Lord's love for us and his mercy which gives birth to our Christian joy. Our Friday sacrifices should lead us to humility before God, as well as gratitude for God's generosity.


