Dear Parishioners,

Sometimes when we hear the words of the Gospel, such as today, that the apostles were effective in conversion or healing, we can ask ourselves: Is this really true? Is this not a metaphor, or a

symbol? You can also look with envy at their effectiveness: "They went out and called for conversion. They also threw away many evil spirits and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them."

Sometimes when I look at the effectiveness of my evangelization and pastoral efforts, I feel very weak. However, it is not worth lamenting over this. You need to focus on God's work. He does not send His apostles one by one, but in pairs. Secondly, He even orders them not to take anything with them. This is a very extreme challenge for the apostles. Similar obstacles face a modern man when surrounded with gadgets and all kinds of people. Is Jesus asking for too much?

The answer to this question is not difficult. Jesus knows each one of us. He knows you and me. He knows your heart, your capabilities, knows how much you are really worth. If He invites you to something, He gives you a vocation; He knows that you can achieve it. He believes in you more than you alone. What is important? To trust Him and people. You cannot act alone in your life if you want to achieve something in evangelization and in the fulfillment of your vocation. You need a community, people who share and believe in the same values as you. One has to accept people with their experience, faith and relationship with Jesus, just as they should rely on you. Only then is the action effective.

Second, it is more important to rely on God. What does it mean not to take anything with me? That's it. "Do not take on me with anything with that would slow your march," said Jesus. If you do not miss anything, you will not take care of the affairs of the kingdom of God. Return to Him for what He gives you, that He will not leave

you and perform miracles in His power. Exactly, miracles ...

If you want to be effective in your evangelistic activities or in fulfilling your vocation, it cannot be only your action, but the action of Christ through you. It must be the action of the community, which is the Church in which Jesus sends you and in which you are not alone. Then your mission will be effective.

This truth applies to every vocation. Spouses who have given themselves the sacrament of marriage do not go through life alone. They have each other, but also Jesus, who joined them. Through this sacrament, He gave them a "package" of graces needed to live together to defeat the demon of infidelity or dissatisfaction. He, in the sacramental marriage, gives the favors necessary for effective evangelization of one another and for the transmission of faith to children. He makes it possible to show the meaning of a married life with the testimony of life.

To be an effective disciple of Jesus, you have to rely on people and on Him, in every vocation. After all, He and the people are the Church ...





Drodzy Parafianie,

Czasem kiedy słyszymy słowa Ewangelii, takie jak dzisiaj, mówiące o tym, że apostołowie byli skuteczni w nawracaniu czy uzdrawianiu, możemy sobie zadać pytania: Czy to rzeczywiście prawda? Czy to nie jest

jakaś metafora, symbol? Można też z zazdrością patrzeć na ich skuteczność: "Oni więc wyszli i wzywali do nawrócenia. Wyrzucali też wiele złych duchów oraz wielu chorych namaszczali olejem i uzdrawiali".

Kiedy czasem patrzę na skuteczność moich wysiłków ewangelizacyjno-duszpasterskich, czuję się naprawdę słaby. Jednak nie warto ubolewać nad tym. Trzeba się skupić nad samym postępowaniem Jezusa. On swoich uczniów nie posyła pojedynczo, ale po dwóch. Po drugie nakazuje im wręcz, żeby niczego ze sobą nie zabierali. To bardzo ekstremalne wyzwanie dla apostołów. Dla współczesnego człowieka, otoczonego gadżetami, ludźmi, jeszcze bardziej ekstremalne, heroiczne wręcz. Czy Jezus wymaga za dużo?

Odpowiedź na to pytanie nie jest trudna. Oczywiście, że nie! Jezus zna każdego z nas. Zna mnie i Ciebie. Zna twoje serce, twoje możliwości, wie, ile naprawdę jesteś wart. Jeżeli do czegoś Cię zaprasza, daje jakieś powołanie, to wie, że jesteś w stanie to osiągnąć. On bardziej wierzy w ciebie niż ty sam. Co jest ważne? Zdać się na Niego i na ludzi. Nie możesz w swoim życiu działać sam, jeżeli chcesz coś osiągnąć na niwie ewangelizacyjnej i realizacji swojego powołania. Potrzebujesz wspólnoty, ludzi, którzy wyznają takie same wartości jak ty, wierzą w to samo, chociaż może w sobie tylko charakterystyczny sposób. Trzeba się czasem zdać na ludzi, na ich doświadczenie, wiarę, relację do Jezusa. Tak jak oni powinni zdać się na Ciebie. Wtedy działanie jest skuteczne.

Po drugie, chociaż to jest ważniejsze, zdać się na Boga. Co to znaczy nie brać ze sobą niczego? Właśnie to. "Nie bierz w drogę ze mną, niczego, co spowolni twój marsz" – mówi Jezus. Jeżeli niczego ci nie będzie brakować, to nie zatroszczysz się o sprawy

królestwa Bożego. Zdaj się na Niego, na to, co ci da, na to, że cię nie opuści i w Jego mocy będziesz dokonywać cudów. Dokładnie, cudów..

Jeżeli chcesz być skuteczny w swoich działaniach ewangelizacyjnych czy w spełnianiu swojego powołania, to nie może to być tylko twoje działanie, ale działanie Chrystusa przez ciebie. Musi to być działanie wspólnoty, jaką jest Kościół, w którym Jezus cię posyła i to nie samego. Wtedy dopiero będzie skuteczne.

Ta prawda odnosi się do każdego powołania. Małżonkowie, którzy udzielili sobie sakramentu małżeństwa, nie idą przez życie samotnie, mają siebie, ale także Jezusa, który ich połączył i przychodząc w tym właśnie sakramencie, dał im "pakiet" łask potrzebnych do tego, by przeżyć życie razem, by pokonać demona niewierności, zniechęcenia. On w małżeństwie sakramentalnym daje łaski potrzebne do skutecznego ewangelizowania siebie nawzajem i przekazywania wiary dzieciom. On uzdalnia do tego, by świadectwem życia ukazywać sens życia małżeńskiego.

Aby być skutecznym uczniem Jezusa, trzeba zdać się na ludzi i na Niego, w każdym powołaniu. Przecież ON i w Nim ludzie to Kościół...

Be Disciples - Make Disciples #6

Missionary disciples are ordinary people called to follow Jesus. How is he calling me? How do I respond?

The call to be a disciple comes from Christ through many diverse people and situations. Some hear the call when they are children. Others become aware of Jesus' invitation to follow him later in life. In every case, the call is personal, an *invitation from our Lord to know and love him intimately*, to be a person for others, to live simply and to grow in holiness through a life of prayer and service.

Am I doing all I can to know and love Jesus Christ intimately? _____ Am I a person for others, self-giving and other-centered? _____ Do I live simply and put God first through prayer and service?

All Christian vocations, including ordained ministry, religious life, marriage and the dedicated single life, require surrender and self-sacrifice. Christian discipleship means embracing a lifestyle that demands discipline, obedience and a commitment to serving all God's people.

Am I disciplined? ____ Am I obedient? ___

Being a missionary disciple is challenging in every age, but especially today. Why? Because everything in our culture argues against being a "person for others." Instead, we are urged to look out for our own interests—first and foremost. The self-centeredness of our culture has no room for discipline, obedience, or a commitment to serving God's people.

Christ calls ordinary people, like you and me, to be his disciples—an invitation that is universal and unqualified; to be self-less, loving God above all things.

All that's necessary to be a faithful missionary disciple of Jesus Christ is the willingness to take up your cross and follow him and lead others to him. No special talents are required. If we surrender our egos and place an absolute trust in God's grace and mercy, the Holy Spirit will show us the way. It's not as scary as some might think.


