Dear Parishioners,

Today's gospel reveals an unusual situation concerning a dishonest and prudent steward, since it looks like Jesus Himself, praises theft and corruption. How can you praise a man who unlawfully appropriates the goods of others and makes friends at the expense of his owner?

Taking a closer look at the parable, we will see that the steward's attitude was not praised, but only his prudence. He understood the situation correctly, thought carefully about what steps were necessary, and acted quickly and decisively. He made no illusions and had no hesitation. As long as he still has some opportunities to act, he strives to secure his livelihood and housing for the time when he will be released. The steward chooses a way out of this difficult situation through another person. Until now, he hardly noticed another person's existence, he only thought about himself and his interests. Now he discovers the value of friendship. Through opening up to others, he finds salvation. Therefore, it is the forethought that openness to other people is praised, and not the ways he uses to secure his future.

Based on this situation, we, as Jesus' disciples, should act with the same foresight, dexterity, and openness to other people as the hero of today's Gospel did. Let's ask ourselves, did God really do a "good deal" by entrusting us with His goods? Let's definitely include intelligence, cleverness, and concern for other people in our everyday lives, all with the view of God's Kingdom, which is offered to each of us.

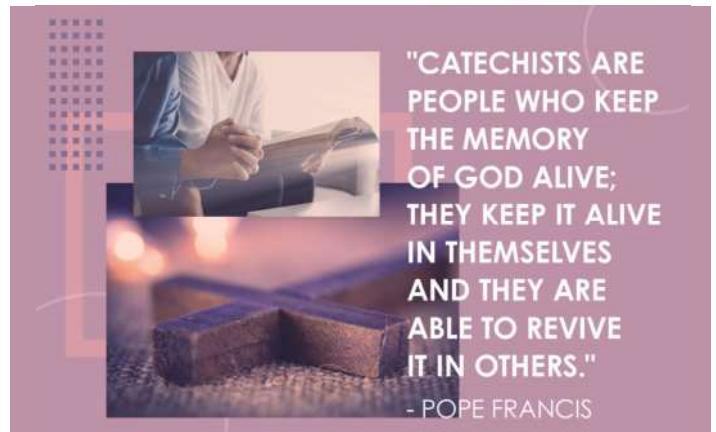

Loving Father, we pray today for our catechists. We thank you for their gift of ministry in your Church.

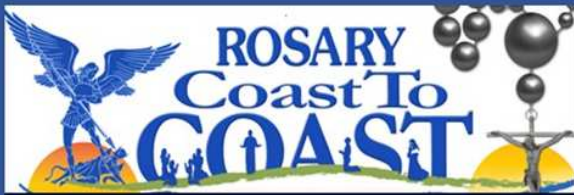
Grant them your wisdom that they may grow in the understanding and teaching of your Word. Grant them also your love that they may be fruitful heralds of your Word and lead others to love you.

Drodzy Parafianie,

Dziwna jest ta dzisiejsza Ewangelia o nieuczciwym i przezornym rządcy, bo wygląda na to, jakby sam Jezus, pochwaliał złodziejstwo i korupcję. Jak można pochwalić człowieka, który przywłaszcza sobie bezprawnie dobra

innych i pozyskuje sobie przyjaciół kosztem właściciela?

Jeśli przyjrzymy się uważniej, zorientujemy się, że nie została pochwalona sama postawa zarządcy, ale tylko jego przezorność. Zrozumiał on właściwie sytuację, przemyślał uważnie, jakie kroki są konieczne, i zadziałał szybko i zdecydowanie. Nie czynił sobie żadnych złudzeń i nie miał ani chwili wahania. Dopóki posiada jeszcze jakieś możliwości działania, stara się zapewnić sobie środki do życia i mieszkanie na ten czas, kiedy będzie już zwolniony. Zarządca wybiera sposób wyjścia z tej trudnej sytuacji poprzez drugiego człowieka. Dotąd prawie nie zauważał ich istnienia, myślał tylko o sobie i o swoich interesach. Teraz odkrywa wartość przyjaźni. Ocalenie siebie dokonuje się przez otwarcie na innych. I właśnie ta jego zapobiegliwość, otwartość na drugiego człowieka, zostaje pochwalona, a nie sposoby, których używa, aby zapewnić sobie przyszłość.

Gdyby tak się dobrze przyjrzeć swoim zachowaniom, to moglibyśmy zobaczyć, że i nasze rachunki wobec Boga nie zawsze są uczciwe. Delikatnie mówiąc, dużo w nich lenistwa, szukania różnego rodzaju przyjemności, nieuczciwości, niedbałości, partactwa i to wszystko dokonuje się w granicach zarządu dobrami, które powierzył nam Pan Bóg.

Na podstawie tej sytuacji my, jako uczniowie Jezusa, powinniśmy działać z taką samą przezornością, zręcznością i otwarciem na drugiego człowieka, jak tego dokonał bohater dzisiejszej Ewangelii. Zapytajmy samych siebie, czy rzeczywiście Pan Bóg zrobił "dobry interes" powierzając nam swoje dobra? Włączmy zdecydowanie w swoją codzienność inteligencję, spryt, zatroskanie o drugiego człowieka, a wszystko to z myślą o Królestwie Bożym, które jest każdemu z nas ofiarowane.
