






Carbon Pricing: A Catholic Solution for Climate?

Following in the footsteps of Pope John Paul II and Benedict XVI, Pope Francis recognizes the scientific consensus that the current problematic warming trend is mostly caused by human activity. Deforestation and burning fossil fuels are major contributors. While some have wrongly turned climate change into a political issue, Pope Francis recognizes it as a social justice and a moral issue. This is because those who will suffer most from the resulting environmental damage are the poor and future generations ... who are least responsible for contributing to the problem.

Francis has called upon individuals, governments, and corporations to make changes to mitigate the problem. He met with top energy company executives who agreed to consider supporting government policies that put a price on carbon. Also in 2019, the US Conference of Catholic Bishops had issued a statement of support for legislation that is now called the Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act (H.R. 5744) that would price carbon emissions to encourage a faster transition to cleaner energy. It would do so in a way that minimizes economic harm to the poor and middle class. Francis himself stated "... carbon pricing is essential if humanity is to use the resources of creation wisely."

Because human suffering will be significant if we fail to adequately address the climate problem, immediate action is required. Carbon pricing could be a part of the solution.



SPIRITUAL ADOPTION OF AN UNBORN CHILD

The members of SS. Cyril and Methodius parish family will have the opportunity to "spiritually" adopt a child who is newly conceived this month. Not all newly conceived babies are allowed to be born. In fact, based on CDC data from 2020, in US alone, about 2,000 babies lose their lives to abortion each day. It is these babies you are being asked to "adopt".

You may "adopt" a child individually or as a family by participating during the weekend of 4/21/24. You can name the child for whom you will be praying, thereby giving the baby the humanity he or she deserves. You will be asked to pray for your unborn child each day for 9 months (a short prayer and one decade of rosary).

There are millions of unborn babies desperately in need of your prayers. Won't you please "spiritually adopt" one and share the love for life that God have given you?

An official pledge to pray will take place during each Holy Mass on Saturday, April 20th and Sunday, April 21st.





IS IT REALLY "OUR" DUTY TO SHARE THE GOSPEL? WHO ME? YES!

In the last century, Catholics were taught to shy away from reading the scriptures on their own or discussing their religion with others. The very thought of evangelization was discouraged and equated with proselytizing. Only the missionaries 'went out' and spread the good news of salvation in Jesus Christ. Think again. Refresh. Update.



THAT IS THE OPPOSITE OF WHAT THE GOSPEL SAYS WE SHOULD BE DOING and is a neglect of our duties as Catholics.

One of Jesus' most explicit commands to us was His Great Commission in Matthew 28:18-20:

Then Jesus approached and said to them, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore," and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.

GO - BAPTIZE - TEACH THEM to observe God's covenant with us.

Evangelization is simply understood as sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ with others so that they make a decision to follow Him, become His disciple, and stay connected to Him – GOD, the source of all power – by participating in the prayers and sacraments of His Holy Catholic Church.

Sharing our faith is not always a simple task, but it is our sacred duty. You may never know if you are having an impact. But do not get discouraged and lose heart. Actively engaging in evangelization always has a positive impact, you might see it in your lifetime, or you might not. The Holy Spirit takes over.



Too many people in today's world accept sin as a way of life, saying "That's just how I am," or "I don't have time to obey the commandments or pray." And they can never find the deep joy of being forgiven and becoming a disciple of Christ. They need you to pray for them, befriend them, share your faith with them, and invite them.


