Dear Parishioners,

So, what is the deal with the Ascension? To many people, especially unbelievers, the story of Jesus ascending into heaven is just some sort of fairy tale. To true believers, the ascension of Jesus was a journey home to his Father. And, just because Jesus went to his home

in heaven, we must not think that he has abandoned us—that he once lived here on earth, but has now gone back to where he really belongs. Nothing could be further from the truth.

If this was true, Christianity would be nothing more than a religion of remembrances like many other non-Christian religions. You know, religions that believe that we only live on in the memories of our children. What a depressing thought that is! After two or three generations, who would remember us? We have to understand that, when Jesus walked the earth, he could only be in one place at a time. Now, he is present everywhere.

There is a story that says that, when Jesus returned to heaven, his Father asked him whom he had left on earth in order to carry out his mission. Jesus proudly told his Father that his friends would do it. "And," God replied, "you mean Peter who betrayed you, and Judas who sold you and all the rest of the disciples who ran away when you were crucified? You mean to tell me that they are going to carry out your work?" Jesus answered, "Yes, Father, they are the only ones, except for Judas." His Father said, "What is your backup plan?" Jesus said, "There is no backup plan. Either they do it or it does not get done. There is no plan B."

My friends, we are the only plan that God has to bring His Good News to other people. We are His only witnesses. We are the ones with the power to show others how to go to heaven. And, if we think about it, this power that God has given us comes with an awesome responsibility—the responsibility to use His gifts to us for His glory—and not just for our own pleasures.

For example, do we use His gift of sexuality only in marriage, where it belongs or do we use it in an unholy and in an unhealthy way? Do we use the gift of our brains to help others, or do we use them only to make as much money as possible, even if it means sticking a knife into the back of someone we perceive as competition? Whatever gifts that God has given us, He wants us to use them to help others see how good He is. Remember, we are His only plan.

Think of someone in the past who helped you. Think of what they said or did for you that changed you for the better—that influenced you to

do some of the good things that you do today. That is all that God asks of us. It is like we are beggars showing other beggars where the food is. Every baptized Catholic must obey the call of Christ to be his witnesses in a world that too often seems indifferent to Christ, a world that regards our faith as an "option"—an "extra" sort of like gardening or playing baseball—you know, do whatever you like. I'm OK and you're OK.

But, everyone, regardless of their beliefs, down deep, has a spiritual hunger. They want someone to reassure them that there is something beyond our life on this earth. They want to know that there is a happy ending, despite all of our wars and famines and illnesses and, most of all, death. This is our opportunity to bring Christ and his "Good News" to them—that there is hope, both on this earth and beyond the grave. Remember, we must bring Jesus to others. We have no choice if we consider ourselves faithful Catholics. We must live as people who are absolutely convinced that life does have meaning; that this world, with all of its problems, is still God's world; that the most powerful force in the universe is not hatred but love—not death but life. Like Jesus said to his Father—we are his only option. There is no plan B.

UWIELBIAMY JEZUSA

Sezon Pięciu Wieczorów Uwielbienia Najświętszego Sakramentu



W piątek, 24 kwietnia, odbył się czwarty, przedostatni w tym sezonie Wieczór Uwielbienia. Nosił on tytuł: „**Uwielbiamy Jezusa w Najświętszym Sakramencie Ołtarza**”.

Był to wieczór szczególny, pełen głębokiej modlitwy i żywej obecności Pana Jezusa Eucharystycznego. Wyróżniał się on wyjątkowym momentem — gdy ks. Paweł niósł Monstrancję nawą główną, następnie nawami bocznymi, aby każdy z obecnych mógł doświadczyć bliskości Jezusa. Ta chwila głęboko poruszyła serca, przynosząc umocnienie i pokój wszystkim, którzy otworzyli się na Jego obecność. To sam Pan Jezus wyszedł nam na spotkanie, pragnąc być jeszcze bliżej każdego z nas.



Ewangelia o kobiecie cierpiącej na krwotok, która dotknęła Jezusa i została uzdrowiona, stała się pięknym nawiązaniem do tej procesji — przypomnieniem, że

także dziś możemy z wiarą „dotykać” Jezusa i doświadczać Jego uzdrawiającej mocy. Śpiew „**Jesteś Królem**” wypełnił cały kościół. Na wezwanie „Podnieśmy wszyscy nasze dłonie” wielu wiernych spontanicznie uniosło ręce, a wspólna modlitwa uwielbienia nabrała szczególnej siły i jedności. Niech łaski otrzymane podczas tego wieczoru przyniosą owoce w codziennym życiu, umacniają wiarę i prowadzą do jeszcze głębszej relacji z Jezusem.



Wieczór zakończył się spotkaniem Agape, podczas którego, przy poczęstunku, był czas na rozmowy, budowanie wspólnoty oraz dzielenie się doświadczeniami.

Serdecznie zapraszamy na ostatni już w tym sezonie Wieczór Uwielbienia, który odbędzie się **w piątek, 15 maja o godzinie 7:00 PM**. Niech to będzie wyjątkowa okazja, by w naszej parafii jeszcze raz uwielbić Pana Jezusa z całych sił, w jedności serc i w mocy wspólnoty wypełniającej świątynię. Pokażmy, że nasza wspólnota Św. Cyryla i Metodego jest silna Bogiem — zjednoczona w wierze i modlitwie. Zaprosimy do uwielbienia naszych bliskich — przyjaciół, znajomych i krewnych. Niech nasze wspólne uwielbienie stanie się świadectwem żywej wiary i otwartości serc na działanie Boga.



Prosimy również o zapisanie w kalendarzu daty **23 maja – Wigilia Zesłania Ducha Świętego**. Wraz z polonijnymi wspólnotami Odnowy w Duchu Świętym oraz Księdzem



Pawłem Komperdą, opiekunem duchowym tych wspólnot, **zapraszamy na czuwanie modlitewne wraz z uroczystą Mszą Świętą**, które będzie miało miejsce w naszym kościele. Niech to czuwanie będzie dla nas pięknym zwieńczeniem tego czasu wspólnego uwielbienia oraz okazją do głębszego spotkania z Duchem Świętym. Więcej szczegółów już wkrótce.





Drodzy Parafianie,

Czym tak naprawdę jest Wniebowstąpienie? Dla wielu osób, zwłaszcza niewierzących, historia Jezusa wstępującego do nieba jest tylko pewnego rodzaju bajką. Dla prawdziwych wierzących, wstąpienie Jezusa do nieba było powrotem do domu Ojca. Właśnie dlatego, że

powrócił do swojego domu w niebie, nie możemy myśleć, że nas opuścił, bo kiedyś żył tutaj na ziemi, a teraz powrócił do miejsca, gdzie naprawdę przynależy. Nie może być nic bardziej mylnego.

Jeśli byłaby to prawda, to chrześcijaństwo byłoby niczym więcej niż tylko religią wspomnień, tak jak wiele innych niechrześcijańskich religii, które uważają, że żyjemy tylko we wspomnieniach naszych dzieci. Czy nie jest to przygnębiające? Kto będzie o nas pamiętał za dwa lub trzy pokolenia? Musimy zrozumieć, że kiedy Jezus chodził po świecie, mógł być tylko w jednym miejscu w czasie, a teraz jest obecny wszędzie.

Jest opowieść, która mówi, że gdy Jezus powrócił do nieba, Jego Ojciec zapytał, kogo pozostawił na ziemi, aby podtrzymywali Jego misję? Jezus dumnie odpowiedział Ojcu, że będą to czynili Jego przyjaciele. "I", odpowiedział Bóg: "masz na myśli Piotra, który Cię zdradził i Judasza, który Cię sprzedał i wszystkich pozostałych uczniów, którzy uciekli, gdy byłeś ukrzyżowany? Chcesz mi powiedzieć, że oni będą kontynuowali Twoją pracę"? Jezus odpowiedział: "Tak, Ojczy, oni z wyjątkiem Judasza". Jego Ojciec zapytał: "Jaki jest Twój plan drugi"? Jezus odpowiedział, "Nie ma żadnego drugiego planu. Uczynią to albo nic z tego nie będzie. Nie ma planu B.

Drodzy przyjaciele, my jesteśmy tym jedynym planem, dzięki któremu Jego dobra nowina jest niesiona innym ludziom. My jesteśmy Jego jedynymi świadkami. My jesteśmy tymi, którzy mają moc pokazania innym drogi do nieba. Jeżeli zastanowimy się nad tym, ta moc, którą otrzymaliśmy od Boga, to także wielka odpowiedzialność - obowiązek korzystania z Jego darów dla Jego chwały, a nie tylko dla własnej przyjemności.

Na przykład, czy z Jego daru seksualności korzystamy tylko w małżeństwie, czyli tam, gdzie powinniśmy, czy też korzystamy z niego w bezbożny i niezdrowy sposób? Czy korzystamy z daru naszego mózgu, aby pomagać innym, czy też używamy go tylko do gromadzenia jak największej ilości pieniędzy, nawet jeśli oznaczałoby to wbicie noża w plecy kogoś, kogo postrzegamy jako konkurencję? On chce, abyśmy przez wszelkie dary otrzymane od Boga, pomogli innym dostrzec jak dobry jest Bóg. Pamiętajmy, jesteśmy Jego jedynym planem.

Pomyśl o kimś z przeszłości, kto ci pomógł. Zastanów się, co zostało ci powiedziane lub uczynione dla ciebie, co sprawiło, że zmieniłeś się na lepsze, co

wpłynęło, że do dzisiaj jesteś dobrym człowiekiem. To jest wszystko, o co prosi nas Bóg. Każdy ochrzczony Katolik jest wezwany do podążania za głosem Chrystusa, aby dawać Jego świadectwo światu, który zbyt często wydaje się być obojętny na Chrystusa - światu, który traktuje naszą wiarę jako „opcję” lub jakiś „dodatek”, coś w rodzaju ogrodnictwa lub gry w baseball, robienia co się podoba. Ja jestem OK i ty jesteś OK.

Każdy, niezależnie od przekonań, gdzieś w głębi ma duchowy głód. Ludzie potrzebują kogoś, kto zapewni ich, że istnieje coś poza naszym ziemskim życiem. Chcą wiedzieć, że jest szczęśliwe zakończenie, pomimo wojen, głodu, chorób, a przede wszystkim śmierci. To jest nasza szansa, aby zanieść im Chrystusa i Jego „Dobrą Nowinę”, że jest nadzieja, zarówno na ziemi, jak i poza grobem. Pamiętajmy, że musimy nieść Chrystusa innym i nie mamy innej możliwości, jeśli uważamy się za wiernych katolików. Musimy żyć jak ludzie, którzy wierzą, że życie ma sens, że ten świat ze wszystkimi jego problemami, jest nadal Bożym światem, że najpotężniejszą siłą we wszechświecie nie jest nienawiść, lecz miłość, nie śmierć lecz życie. Tak jak Jezus powiedział do swojego Ojca, my jesteśmy Jego jedynym planem. Nie ma planu B.
