**Dear Parishioners,**

Today's Gospel should be close to each and every one of us, in which once again Christ shows us how a Christian, that is, a faithful person, should confirm his identity. He asks each of us today about our love for God, and our love for others.

It was Jesus who showed us the most beautiful example of unbounded love capable of sacrifice. This is the love that came two thousand years ago to the earth and then died on the cross for its persecutors. This is the love that is more powerful than death. From this boundless love Christ gives His life for us, gives us eternal life, wants us to be joyful, calls us His friends. He has chosen us, each of us. But many do not accept this choice. A man who accepts his choice chooses Jesus. And to choose Jesus, to grow a friendship with Him, to listen to what He says is to follow His commandments because this is the only way to show Him your love.

Every law is to keep and to order the principles of interpersonal functioning in the world, and not - as ignorant people say - to break it. Similarly, God's law organizes our reference to Christ and to other people. It also points to proper understanding and experiencing self-love. Who I am is very much revealed in how I act. Often in our lives we forget that love requires sacrifices, and sometimes you have to pay a huge price for it. Even though in our lives there are difficult, painful moments, moments of trial, it is then when we can see, like in the mirror, what our love really is.

Jesus always puts our happiness first, and according to God, nothing makes us more joyful than caring for God's love. If a man neglects God's teaching, his innermost feeling will remain insatiable and restless. And then nothing fulfills us; not huge savings accounts, palaces with exquisite gardens, exclusive limousines parked in front of our home or friendships with the world's largest moguls. Nothing gives us true happiness if there is no love in our lives.

Let us pray for this love from Jesus, who loves each one of us as we are. Let us love other

people, how God loves us. Let us learn God's love from Him and pray every day for true and unconditional love, to give us the courage to live it every day.

Drodzy Parafianie,

Jakże bliska każdemu z nas powinna być ta dzisiejsza Ewangelia, w której po raz kolejny Chrystus pokazuje nam, w jaki sposób chrześcijanin, czyli osoba Mu wierna, powinna potwierdzić swoją tożsamość. Pyta dzisiaj każdego z nas o miłość do Boga, o miłość do drugiego człowieka.

To właśnie Jezus ukazał najpiękniejszy przykład bezgranicznej miłości zdolnej do poświęceń. To miłość przychodząca dwa tysiące lat temu na ziemię i umierająca na krzyżu za swoich prześladowców. To miłość potężniejsza od śmierci. Z tej bezgranicznej miłości Chrystus oddaje za nas życie swoje, daje nam życie wieczne, pragnie dla nas radości, nazywa nas przyjaciółmi swymi. To On nas wybrał, każdego z nas, ale wielu nie akceptuje tego wyboru. Człowiek, który zaakceptuje Jego wybór, wybiera Jezusa. A wybrać Jezusa, to zawrzeć z Nim przyjaźń, to słuchać tego, co mówi, to wypełniać Jego przykazania, bo tylko w ten sposób można okazać Mu swoją miłość.

A każde Prawo jest po to, aby je zachowywać i aby porządkować zasady międzyludzkiego funkcjonowania w świecie, a nie – jak mawiają ignoranci – po to, aby je łamać. Podobnie prawo Boże – porządkuje nasze odniesienie do Chrystusa i nasze odniesienie do innych ludzi. Wskazuje również na właściwe rozumienie i przeżywanie miłości własnej. To, kim jestem, bardzo mocno objawia się w tym, w jaki sposób postępuję. Często w swoim życiu zapominamy, że miłość wymaga wyrzeczeń, czasami trzeba zapłacić za nią olbrzymią cenę. I choć w naszym życiu są chwile trudne, bolesne, momenty próby, to właśnie wtedy możemy zobaczyć jak w zwierciadle, jaka tak naprawdę jest nasza miłość.

Jezusowi zawsze chodzi o szczęście człowieka i według Niego nic tak nie uszczęśliwia jak troska o miłowanie Boga. Jeśli człowiek lekceważy Jego naukę, jego wnętrze pozostanie nienasycone i niespokojne. I wówczas na nic nam miliony na koncie, pałace z wykwinutymi ogrodami, ekskluzywne limuzyny zaparkowane przed naszym domem, znajomości z największymi potentatami światowymi, jeśli w naszym życiu nie będzie miłości.

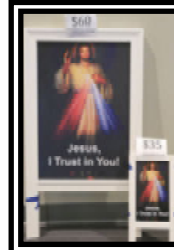

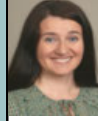

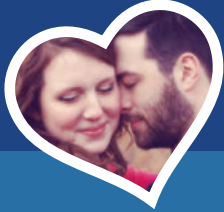
