Dear Parishioners,

“Lazarus, come out!” Come out, Lazarus. Come out of the tomb. Come out of the darkness. Come out of the stench. Come out of death. “Lazarus, come out!”

Somewhere along the line, I must have had a name change that I didn’t realize. You, too. I think my name really was Lazarus. Maybe, if you think about it, Lazarus was also your name. I figure that my name was Lazarus because I didn’t just live among the dead—I was dead. And where I was, it stank. It was foul and dark. For I, like perhaps you, lived in a world of sin, joining in every now and then. Sometimes, the sin was in the accumulation of stuff. Sometimes, the sin was in the refusal to control what I said or did. Sometimes, the sin was in selfish indulgence. Many times, the sin was in ignoring the needs of others, as the rich man did to Lazarus. The particular sins might be different for everyone, “but all of us—including the finest people I have ever met—have not just lived among the dead; we have chosen to be dead ourselves. “Lazarus, come out!”

And so, Jesus calls us, you and me: “Lazarus, come out!” Someone else has done the heavy lifting. Someone else rolled away the stone for us. Jesus did this through the sacrificial love of the Cross, but we still have to come out ourselves. and we must leave the familiar comfort of our self-centered lives and walk toward the voice—walk toward Jesus, the One who is calling us. And we have walked to Him. And life is so much more beautiful now! The air is fresh. We had forgotten how great it was. The birds are singing. Our ears are no longer ringing with the noise of selfishness. Life smells good. Life is beautiful now as we walk toward the One who is calling us, as we walk toward Jesus. And Jesus says, “I called you from the tomb so others can live also. I need you to be my voice. I need you to call out.”

We look around us. The gossip—It is as though the only joy that some people have in their lives is tearing down others. The using—So many people only have one thought when it comes to another person: “What’s in it for me?” The hollow

joy of momentary pleasures. The “party-now, worry-later” attitude that results in self-destruction. The selfishness that locks us into a downward spiral. And we recognize the frustration of so many around us, the frustration that had been under the thin surface of our own lives. And we call out to others: “Lazarus, come out!”

So many who are all wrapped up in their little worlds see you, see me, and say, “I want to be happy like him, like her.” Our very happiness—our living the life of Jesus Christ—calls out to others, “Lazarus, come out of that tomb!” By seeking union with the One to whom we walk when we leave our tombs, we call others to join us: “Lazarus, come out!” By living a Christian lifestyle, even though that means being different than those who brag about their immorality, even though that means being holy, for being different is being holy, our very lives call out to all, “Lazarus, come out!” Why should I live in a dark, foul tomb? Why should you? Why should anyone live among the dead?

Listen, listen to the voice. Walk toward the voice. Help others to listen. Let them listen to His voice in us. And so we shout to the world with our lives: “Walk with us and with Lazarus. Walk with us to the One who is the Lord of Life!”


Last Lenten Soup Dinner March 27





SPIRITUAL ADOPTION OF AN UNBORN CHILD

The members of the SS. Cyril and Methodius and St. James at Sag Bridge parish family are invited to participate in a special opportunity to “spiritually” adopt a child who has just been conceived. Sadly, not

all babies are allowed to be born. According to CDC data from 2024, in the United States alone, about 2,800 babies lose their lives to abortion each day. It is these little ones that we are called to protect in prayer.

You may “adopt” a child individually or as a family during the weekend of March 22, 2026. You are asked to pray for their unborn child daily for nine months, offering a short prayer and one decade of the Rosary.

As St. John Paul II taught, every life is sacred, and Carlo Acutis reminds us that prayer—even for those we may never meet—can make a difference. Millions of unborn babies need our prayers. Will you share God's gift of life by spiritually adopting one?



UWIELBIAMY JEZUSA

Sezon Pięciu Wieczorów Uwielbienia Najświętszego Sakramentu



W sobotę, 28 lutego, w naszym kościele odbył się drugi Wieczór Uwielbienia pod hasłem „Uwielbiamy Najświętszą Krew Jezusa”. Modlitwie ponownie przewodniczył ks. Paweł Komperda. Piękna muzyka, śpiew oraz dekoracja kościoła nawiązująca do tajemnicy Najświętszej Krwi Chrystusa wprowadziły zgromadzonych w atmosferę modlitwy i skupienia. Szczególnym momentem była modlitwa spontaniczna, podczas której każdy mógł własnymi słowami oddać chwałę Bogu. Po zakończeniu nabożeństwa spotkaliśmy się na wspólnej Agape. W radosnej atmosferze wspólnoty można było napić się herbaty, porozmawiać i podzielić się doświadczeniem wspólnej modlitwy. **Był to piękny czas budowania więzi i radości ze spotkania – zarówno z Jezusem, jak i z drugim człowiekiem.** Dziękujemy wszystkim, którzy włączyli się w przygotowanie tego wyjątkowego wieczoru modlitwy i wspólnoty.

Czym jest Adoracja Najświętszego Sakramentu?

Wyobraź sobie, że możesz spędzić chwilę z kimś, kogo kochasz najbardziej na świecie. Nie trzeba wiele mówić ani robić – wystarczy po prostu być razem. Właśnie tym jest adoracja Najświętszego Sakramentu: prostym i pełnym miłości spotkaniem z żywym Jezusem Chrystusem obecnym w konsekrowanej Hostii.



Owoce spotkania z Jezusem w Najświętszym Sakramencie:

- ♦ **Pokój serca:** W ciszy przed Najświętszym Sakramentem możemy powierzyć Jezusowi nasze troski i lęki. Jego obecność przynosi pokój, którego nie daje świat.
- ♦ **Bliskość z Bogiem:** Adoracja pomaga nam pogłębiać osobistą relację z Jezusem i rozmawiać z Nim jak z najbliższym Przyjacielem.
- ♦ **Siła w trudnościach:** Spotkanie z Jezusem w Eucharystii daje nam umocnienie do niesienia codziennych krzyży i pokonywania życiowych trudności.
- ♦ **Światło w decyzjach:** W ciszy łatwiej usłyszeć Boże prowadzenie i rozeznawać właściwą drogę w naszym życiu.

**Drodzy Parafianie,**

“Łazarzu, wyjdź na zewnątrz!” Wyjdź na zewnątrz, Łazarzu. Wyjdź z grobu. Wyjdź z ciemności. Wyjdź ze smrodu. Przyjdź do żywych. “Łazarzu, wyjdź na zewnątrz!”

Moje imię musiało gdzieś zostać zmienione i nawet o tym nie wiedziałem. Ty zapewne też nie. Myślę, że moje prawdziwe imię to Łazarz, a jak się nad tym zastanowimy, to wy też mieliście na imię Łazarz. Doszedłem do tego wniosku, ponieważ nie tylko żyłem wśród umarłych, ja byłem umarły, cuchnąłem, byłem ohydny i w ciemnościach, bo ja, może tak jak i ty żyliśmy w świecie grzechu, łącząc się od czasu do czasu. Niekiedy grzech odmawiał kontroli nad tym, co mówię lub czynię i samolubnie oddawał się nałogowi. Wielokrotnie grzech ignorował potrzeby innych, podobnie jak czynił bogacz innemu człowiekowi o imieniu Łazarz. Dla każdego z nas grzechy mogą być inne, ale wszyscy, włącznie z najlepszymi ludźmi, których spotkałem na swojej drodze, wszyscy nie tylko żyliśmy pośród umarłych, ale z wyboru byliśmy umarli. “Łazarzu, wyjdź na zewnątrz!”

I tak Jezus wzywa Ciebie i mnie, “Łazarzu, wyjdź na zewnątrz!” Ktoś inny zrobił za nas ciężką robotę. Ktoś inny odsunął dla nas głaz. Jezus uczynił to wszystko przez ofiarną miłość krzyża, ale to my sami musimy wyjść na zewnątrz. Musimy opuścić zacisze naszego grobu. Musimy opuścić cuchnący, ohydny i znajomy nam komfort skoncentrowanego na sobie życia i skierować się w stronę głosu, iść do Jezusa, iść do tego, który nas wzywa. Musimy do Niego iść. Teraz życie staje się o wiele piękniejsze! Możemy oddychać świeżym powietrzem. My zapomnieliśmy już, jak to dobrze być na świeżym powietrzu. Śpiewają ptaki. W uszach nie słyszymy już dźwięków egoizmu. Nasze życie znowu pachnie. Życie jest piękne, kiedy idziemy do Tego, który nas wzywa, kiedy idziemy do Jezusa. Jezus mówi, „Wezwałem was z grobu, aby inni też mogli żyć. Musicie być moim głosem. Musicie wołać.”

Popatrzmy wokół siebie. Plotki. Tak jakby radość, którą niektórzy mają w swoim życiu rozrywała innych. Wykorzystywanie. Jeśli chodzi o drugiego człowieka wielu ludzi ma tylko jedną myśl: „Co ja z tej osoby mogę mieć dla siebie?” Pusta radość chwilowej przyjemności. Teraz zabawa a martwił będę się później, taka postawa prowadzi tylko do autodestrukcji. Egoizm,

który nas zamyka w spirali. Dostrzeżliśmy frustrację wielu osób wokół nas, frustrację, która była pod cienką powierzchnią naszego własnego życia i zawołaliśmy do innych: “Łazarzu, wyjdź na zewnątrz!”

Tak wielu zamkniętych w swoich małych światach dostrzeżga gdzieś Ciebie, widzi mnie i mówi, „Ja chcę być tak samo szczęśliwy jak on, jak ona.” Nasze szczęście, nasze życie w Chrystusie woła innych, “Łazarzu, wyjdź na zewnątrz!” Szukając jedności z Tym, do którego idziemy po wyjściu z naszego grobu, zachęcamy innych do przyłączenia się do nas: “Łazarzu, wyjdź na zewnątrz!” Żyjąc po chrześcijańsku, nawet jeśli oznaczyłoby to być innym od tych, którzy chwalać się swoją niemoralnością, nawet jeśli oznaczałoby to być świętym, to będąc innym stajemy się świętymi i nasze własne życie wzywa innych, “Łazarzu, wyjdź na zewnątrz!” Dlaczego ja miałbym żyć w ciemnym, ohydny grobie? Dlaczego miałbyś i ty? Dlaczego ktokolwiek miałby żyć pośród umarłych?




Lenten Check-Up: Our RELATIONSHIP with Our SUFFERING LORD

In this holy season of Lent, we continue along the quiet, demanding, and grace-filled path that leads us toward the heart of Christ. Lent is ultimately an invitation into relationship — a relationship shaped by love, sacrifice, and the mystery of redemption. The Church reminds us that these forty days mirror Christ's own journey into the desert, where He embraced hunger, solitude, and temptation **not for His own sake, but for ours**. In that same spirit, Lent becomes a time when we allow our own struggles, limitations, and daily crosses to be drawn into His saving work.

This Lenten season asks something both simple and profound: that we unite our suffering to Christ's suffering. Not because pain is good in itself, but because Christ has transformed suffering into a place of encounter. When life brings its own unchosen burdens — illness, disappointment, loneliness, uncertainty — Lent teaches us that these too can become offerings when placed in the hands of the One who carried the Cross.

Uniting our suffering to Christ does not mean pretending our hardships are small or easy. It means trusting that nothing we endure is wasted when it is offered with love. **Christ does not remove our crosses; He shoulders them with us.**

This holy season invites us to walk together with renewed intention. Slow down. Notice where God is stirring. **Let our sacrifices and sufferings soften our hearts rather than harden them.** And remember that Lent is always oriented toward Easter — **toward the victory already won, the mercy already given, and the hope that never fails.**
