From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners, I and the Father are one...

In the midst of Our Lord's touching words that call to mind the soft and cuddling images of Jesus as the Good Shepherd we get His strong

and challenging words that contain the teaching that got Him crucified in the first place. Now, my fingers are almost trembling when I write these next few words. So radical and so illogical to the mindset of the Jewish people was this proclamation by Jesus, I'm tempted to say that the Jews had to kill him. How can I even think these thoughts? It is only in entering the ancient thinking of the Old Testament that the statement of Jesus, declaring Himself one with the Father, appears worthy of the highest condemnation. Those that wanted Him dead were doing their best to protect the very essence of monotheism. There is only one God. According to everything they have come to believe over almost 2,000 years of faith, if Jesus is equal to the Father, monotheism itself would collapse. The pagans with their multiple gods would prove to be right. How could the Jews possibly abandon monotheism?

Mere human wisdom and logic have no path to accept an idea of two equal gods or three or a hundred. This is why stories of pagan gods battling for superiority abound. This is why we say belief in the Trinity is a mystery. This is why we say no one can explain the Trinity with mere human logic. In short, we say, it takes Grace to believe in our Trinitarian Deity. But let me share a philosophical thought about the Trinity that helps us accept what is revealed through Grace. First, the explanation about the Trinity comes not so much in meditating on the concept of God as in the concept of "logic". It comes in meditating on our human capacity to equate the idea of "person" with the idea of "God".

According to human logic, every time we see a "person" we see a "single person". Over "humanizing" God has always been a human error. Our logic declares, if Jesus the person is God and God His Father is God, then necessarily there must be two gods. Right? Wrong. No human being is a being of two persons, but that does not exclude the idea that an infinite being can be two persons. In one

of Jordan Peterson's lectures, he points out the unique perspective of the Apostle John. He is the author of those precious words that are repeated in every Traditional Latin Mass... "and the word was made flesh". As John wanted Christianity to penetrate into the pagan world of the Greeks, he realized that the more "Jewish" approach of St Matthew didn't cut mustard. Matthew used all that genealogy stuff and references to ancient Jewish rituals. The Greeks didn't care about all that. John knew the Greeks had this love of philosophy, or human logic, so he uses this powerful statement of Jesus, being one with His Father, to tickle their intellects. Do you like having your intellect tickled? I do. That's why I like theology. That's why it is so important to study the Catechism. Be aware of heresies. Many abound today. Marvel in Catholic wisdom.



Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie, Ja i Ojciec jedno jesteśmy...

Pośród wzruszających słów naszego Pana, które przywołują obrazy Jezusa jako Dobrego Pasterza, pojawiają się Jego mocne i wymagające słowa, pełne

nauki, które doprowadziły Go do ukrzyżowania. Muszę przyznać, że moje palce niemal drżą, gdy piszę te kolejne słowa. Tak radykalne i tak nielogiczne dla mentalności żydowskiego ludu było to, co Jezus ogłosił, że aż jestem skłonny powiedzieć, iż Żydzi musieli Go zabić. A więc jak ja mogę w ogóle tak myśleć? Tylko poprzez zanurzenie się w starożytnym myśleniu Starego Testamentu można dostrzec, że Jezus, deklarując swoją jedność z Ojcem, zasługiwał w ich oczach na najwyższe potępienie. Ci, którzy chcieli Go zabić, robili wszystko, by chronić samą istotę monoteizmu. Istnieje tylko jeden Bóg. Według wszystkiego, w co wierzyli przez niemal 2000 lat swojej wiary, jeśli Jezus jest równy Ojcu, sam monoteizm by się zawalił. Poganom, wierzącym w wielu bogów, przyznano by rację. Jak więc Żydzi mogli porzucić monoteizm?

Ludzka mądrość i logika nie mają drogi do zaakceptowania idei dwóch równych bogów, trzech czy nawet stu. Dlatego w mitologiach pogańskich roi się od opowieści o bogach walczących o władzę. Dlatego mówimy, że wiara w Trójcę Świętą jest tajemnicą. Dlatego twierdzimy, że nie da się jej wytłumaczyć wyłącznie ludzką logiką. Krótko mówiąc – potrzeba łaski, aby uwierzyć w naszego Trójjedynego Boga. Ale pozwól, że podzielę się filozoficzną refleksją o Trójcy Świętej, która może pomóc nam przyjąć to, co objawione jest przez łaskę. Otóż wyjaśnienie Trójcy nie wynika tak bardzo z rozważań nad samą koncepcją Boga, jak raczej z refleksji nad pojęciem logiki. Chodzi o naszą ludzką zdolność do utożsamiania pojęcia "osoba" z pojęciem "Bóg".

Według ludzkiej logiki każda "osoba", jaką widzimy jest jedną pojedynczą osobą. Nadmierne "uczłowieczanie" Boga zawsze było błędem ludzkości. Nasza logika podpowiada: jeśli Jezus jako osoba jest Bogiem, a Bóg Ojciec jest Bogiem, to koniecznie muszą być dwoma bogami. Prawda? Otóż nie. Żaden człowiek nie jest istotą składającą się z dwóch osób, ale to nie wyklucza możliwości, że istota nieskończona może być dwiema osobami. W jednej ze swoich wykładów Jordan

Peterson zwraca uwagę na wyjątkową perspektywę Apostoła Jana. To on jest autorem tych cennych słów, które powtarza się w każdej tradycyjnej łacińskiej Mszy: "A Słowo stało się ciałem". Jan chcąc, by chrześcijaństwo dotarło do świata pogańskich Greków, zdał sobie sprawę, że bardziej "żydowskie" podejście św. Mateusza do Ewangelii na nich nie działało. Mateusz stosował te wszystkie genealogie i odniesienia do dawnych żydowskich rytuałów. Grecy nie dbali o to. Ale Jan wiedział, że Grecy kochają filozofię i ludzką logikę, dlatego użył tego potężnego stwierdzenia Jezusa – "Ja i Ojciec jedno jesteśmy" – aby pobudzić ich intelekt. A więc ja zapytuje; Czy lubisz, gdy twój intelekt jest pobudzany? Bo ja tak. Dlatego kocham teologię. Dlatego tak ważne jest studiowanie Katechizmu. Natomiast uważaj na herezje – jest ich dziś wiele. Bardziej wartościowe jest zachwycać się katolicką mądrością.






