Dear Parishioners,
The question of salvation, asked by someone in today's Gospel is a question of everything.

Although you may have everything in life, if you lose your salvation, what will remain? It might be difficult for us to think or reflect about salvation every day and what will happen to us after death. We are tangled in so many difficult things on Earth, so many unresolved problems, so many worries about the upcoming days, how to survive, how to solve past, present, and upcoming issues, how not to run out of money, how to keep your job and perform well, so that nothing bad can happen to you and to your family, how to arrange everything to live a happy life. In these circumstances, how can you possibly think about salvation?

Today's Gospel begins with the sentence: *As He taught, Jesus walked through cities and villages ...* It is not important whether I live in a city or in a village; it doesn't matter if I have a beautiful, large house or if I share a room with my sister or brother; it is not important whether I still have new things to boast about. It doesn't matter how much I have, where I haven't been this summer or how many people know me on Facebook. This will all pass someday. It is important that Jesus' teachings "come and stay" with me. Jesus wants to stay with me: when I pray, when I'm at work, when I'm with relatives I do not know how to get along with, or when it is sometimes difficult to sleep. Jesus wants to be a part of my "life's baggage". He wants to bring His salvation - that is, Himself - because He is Salvation.

But will there be a place in my heart for Him or is my heart already filled with other matters of this world? Sometimes this

happens to the people tangled in only Earth's matters, not God's, not the salvation He is offering. Then it is difficult for the good within us to win, to replace anger with forgiveness, criticism and judgment for a chance to do good deeds. Instead of waiting for someone to change, start converting yourself. This is God's way of doing salvation on Earth and the path to heaven.

Jesus calls us today to convert us, to choose a narrow door. To get to heaven, it is not enough to say that you knew Jesus, that you heard about Him in church, that you went to Mass. True knowledge of Jesus continues after leaving church, in the way we treat people, what we say about others, and the example of Jesus that you demonstrate to all.

Let today's Gospel help us connect faith with everyday life even more, turn us away from what is sinful, and allow us to lead a just life with an open heart, in which there is no absence of God, and then we will surely enter heaven.



Drodzy Parafianie,
Pytanie o zbawienie, które ktoś postawił Jezusowi w dzisiejszej Ewangelii jest pytaniem o wszystko. Bo można mieć w życiu wszystko, ale jak się straci zbawienie, to cóż pozostanie? Może na co dzień

trudno nam myśleć o zbawieniu, o tym, co będzie z nami po śmierci. Tyle przecież na ziemi różnych trudnych spraw, tyle nierozwiązanych problemów, tyle troski o najbliższe dni, o to jak przeżyć, co zrobić, by nie brakło pieniędzy, by w pracy się utrzymać, by nic złego nam się nie przydarzyło, by w rodzinie znów wszystko dobrze się poukładało. Jak tu w tym wszystkim myśleć o zbawieniu?

Dzisiejsza Ewangelia rozpoczęła się zdaniem: Jezus nauczając, szedł przez miasta i wsie... To nie takie ważne, czy mieszkam w mieście czy na wsi; to nie takie ważne, czy mam piękny i duży dom, czy może dzielę jeden pokój z moją siostrą czy bratem; to nie takie ważne, czy mam wciąż nowe rzeczy, którymi się mogę pochwalić, czy tylko to, co już może modne nie jest, ale na inne mnie nie stać. To w końcu nie takie ważne, ile mam, gdzie w te wakacje jeszcze nie byłem, ile ludzi mnie zna na Facebooku... To wszystko kiedyś przeminie. Ważne jest to, że Jezus nauczając przechodzi i chce się u mnie „zatrzymać”, chce ze mną pobyc: kiedy się modłę, kiedy w pracy coś mi nie wychodzi, kiedy z najbliższymi nie wiem, jak się dogadać, kiedy trudno czasami zasnąć, bo tyle spraw jeszcze niezalutowanych. Jezus chce wejść w to wszystko, chce wnieść w to swoje zbawienie – czyli siebie, bo On jest Zbawieniem.

Tylko czy w moim sercu znajdzie się miejsce dla Niego, czy nie jest w nim już zbyt ciasno od innych spraw tego świata? Bywa tak czasem u ludzi, że na wszystko jest w sercu miejsce, a najmniej jest go dla Boga. Trudno się wtedy precyzyjnie, by dobro w nas zwyciężyło, by złość zastąpić przebaczeniem, by zamiast krytykować i osądzać ludzi, pomyśleć, co by dla nich zrobić, by zamiast czekać aż ktoś się zmieni, samemu zacząć się

nawracać. A to jest właśnie Boża droga czynienia zbawienia już na ziemi i droga prowadząca do nieba.

Wzywa nas dzisiaj Jezus byśmy się nawracali, byśmy wybierali ciasne drzwi, byśmy się nie zgadzali na dwulicowość w życiu. Nie wystarczy wchodząc kiedyś do nieba, powiedzieć, że znało się Jezusa, że słyszało się o Nim w kościele, że chodziło się na Msze Święte. Może okazać się to być niewystarczające. Prawdziwa znajomość Jezusa sprawdza się po wyjściu z kościoła, po tym jak traktujemy ludzi, co mówimy o innych, jakie są nasze czyny i jaki przykład życia widzą w nas inni ludzie.

Niech dzisiejsza Ewangelia pomoże nam jeszcze bardziej łączyć wiarę z codziennym życiem, nawracać się z tego, co grzeszne, i prowadzić sprawiedliwe życie, w którym nie brakuje miejsce dla Boga i serca dla drugiego człowieka, a wtedy napewno do nieba wejdziemy.

Why? To help children grades K-4 to better understand the Sunday readings and apply the Holy Scriptures to their young lives. Our first year this past year was wonderful!

When? Every Sunday during 9:30 AM Mass, September 7th through May 31st **except Easter.**

How will it work?

1. Families with participating children please sit in the front half of church during 9:30 Sunday morning Mass.
2. After the opening Mass prayers, the Adult Leaders will approach the altar carrying the book of Gospels as the children quietly line up behind them with folded hands, gathering in the center front of the church. The teen helpers will assist.


