Jesus in today's Gospel indicates the transience of this world. While Jesus is in Jerusalem's temple, He hears conversations about its

external beauty. Note, at that time there was only one temple of Judaism located in Jerusalem. It was one of the most magnificent and delightful buildings of all antiquity. Then Jesus foretells of her falling, which occurred in the seventieth year, when the temple was completely destroyed by the Romans, and has not been rebuilt to this day.

It will return for a longer time than just a moment of prayer; it will come back forever - because it will derive from entrusting your life to Jesus. Jesus, I trust in You... Dear Parents and Parishioners, Week Twelve Recap

Thank you to all the parents who joined us for last week's Parent—Teacher Conferences. Your time, questions, and partnership make a real difference in your child's learning — we appreciate your engagement and the conversations about goals and next steps. If you weren't able to meet or would like a follow-up, please contact your child's teacher — we're here to support your child together.

A special thank you to those who attended our i-Ready presentations. i-Ready is a transformational tool that gives us K-12 diagnostics and personalized learning pathways that we use to set and monitor school, teacher, and student growth goals, help with lesson planning and student grouping, and guide teacher—student data talks (i-Ready overview and school uses).

- The early results are encouraging: 92% of students are already at or within one grade level in reading and 88% are already at or within one grade level in math at the start of the year—strong evidence of last year's preparation.
- Compared with last year we reduced the percentage of students two or more grade levels below in reading by 2%, and increased the percent of students at mid-or-above grade level in math by 2%.
- Looking ahead, we're asking teachers to push higher-level thinking (DOK 3-4) and are aiming for 85% of students at grade level in reading (moving toward 90%) and 78% at grade level in math (also progressing toward 90%); our Catholic identity goal is that 100% of students agree, "God is present in my life."

Why to we "have to" go to Mass? - Part 1

Whether you're a 3rd grader, a grandparent, or anything in between, at some point you've probably struggled with the question, "Why do we have to go to Mass?"

Sometimes you don't feel like going to church.

You may not like the homilies or the music.

Maybe you think Mass is boring.

You may not feel welcomed.

You might try to convince yourself that you can pray anywhere.

The Power of Negative Thinking

Even though you know that going to Mass is a good thing, you can talk yourself out of going by focusing on the negatives. At first, you may feel a little guilty, but eventually, you can justify your decision by convincing yourself that you are too busy, too tired, too bored, too frustrated.

When that happens, you miss the great gift that God gives us in the Eucharist!

Thinking Positively

What if you changed your attitude about going to Mass? What if you began to think of Mass as the time in the day when you can connect with God and with other people in a special way? What if you concentrated on the things you like about your parish instead of what you don't like? What if you made Mass a priority?

The effects of these kinds of positive attitudes may surprise you. Research studies show that people who go to church every week are:

- Less likely to suffer from depression.
- Less likely to abuse drugs or alcohol.
- More likely to have a solid sense of right and wrong.
- More likely to live a longer and happier life.





- Please return all gift cards and clothing items by SUNDAY, DECEMBER 7th.


