

#### Dear Parishioners,

Although in today's Gospel we hear about wealth, profits, and bankers, the true liturgy message is not an economic matter. Notice the behavior of the man in the parable who spoke to his servants.

Both the first and the second of the servants, regardless of the amount of profit, were praised in the same way: "Well done, my good and faithful servant. Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities..." It was only the faithfulness of the people praised and not the profit, as they were trying to fulfill the task to their best ability.

Talent in biblical language can mean not only wealth, but also ability, gift of intelligence, capability to pursue goals, as well as health or beauty. We often hear about talented people, but we rarely see unique talents in ourselves. In everyday conversations and observations, it is much easier to list what we lack than what we have been given.

We agree that any individual with many "talents," whether materialistic, intellectual or spiritual, should not keep them to themselves. The gifted person was simultaneously called to share and to develop the gift he received. The problem arises when we notice the lack of "talent." How do we carry on in the absence of the desired health or external success when the unity of the family is at risk, when we perceive the limitations of our abilities such as lack of knowledge or experience? What do we do with fear or doubt, which in such situations immediately appears in the heart?

From the perspective of our faith, all these difficult situations are simultaneously a challenge for mankind. Even the suffering, the health threat, the drama of the broken family, the failed exam or the loss of work, might become a turning point in human life. God might give you a chance to find him. From the perspective of all human life, these situations often turn out to be a challenge rather than a tragedy. Precisely in difficult situations, which paradoxically can be

biblical "talents," God expects mankind to be faithful and active.

The most common error in humans, however, is that when we see "intractable problems," we would most likely hide, disappear, push to oblivion, and wait idly as the last of the three servants of the evangelical parable did. In the moment of idleness, inspired by the fear of oneself, jealousy and accusations quickly appear in us. Instead of remaining faithful, it is much easier for us to escape from problems in solitude, trying to forget about them. Only faithfulness and human commitment in developing talents, and above all, trust in God can bear fruit after our departure.

Let's ask ourselves today: what talents have influenced my faith and perseverance? Can I thank God not only for the talents that bring prosperity, but also for those that, despite the difficulties, may be a chance for me?


Thanksgiving

The First Thanksgiving
(the true story)

#### Drodzy Parafianie,

Mimo, że w Ewangelii, słyszymy dziś o majątku, o zyskach i o bankierach, to prawdziwym przesłaniem dzisiejszej liturgii słowa nie są sprawy ekonomiczne. Zwróćmy uwagę na zachowanie człowieka z przypowieści,

który rozmawiał ze swoimi sługami. Zarówno pierwszego, jak i drugiego ze sług, bez względu na wielkość zysku, pochwalił w ten sam sposób: "sługo dobry i wierny. Byłeś wierny w niewielu rzeczach, na wieloma cię postawię...". Pochwalony został nie sam zysk, tylko wierność ludzi, którzy na miarę swoich możliwości realizowali otrzymane zadanie.

Talent w języku biblijnym może oznaczać niekoniecznie tylko majątek, ale również zdolności, dar inteligencji, umiejętność dążenia do celu, a także zdrowie, czy urodę. Właściwie często słyszymy o ludziach utalentowanych, rzadziej zaś dostrzegamy u siebie samych jakieś talenty niezwykłe. W codziennych rozmowach i obserwacjach zdecydowanie łatwiej jest nam wymienić to, czego nam brakuje, niż to czym zostaliśmy obdarowani.

Nikt z nas nie ma wątpliwości, że każdy właściciel 'talentów', czy to materialnych, czy intelektualnych lub duchowych, nie powinien zatrzymywać ich tylko dla siebie. Człowiek obdarowany, został równocześnie powołany do tego, by dzielić się i zarazem rozwijać otrzymany dar. Problem pojawia się wtedy, gdy zauważamy u siebie brak 'talentu'. Jak postępować w sytuacji, gdy brakuje upragnionego zdrowia, zewnętrznych sukcesów, kiedy zagrożona jest jedność w rodzinie, kiedy dostrzegamy ograniczoność swoich zdolności, brak wiedzy czy doświadczenia? Co zrobić z bojaźnią, zwątpieniem, ogromnym lękiem, który w takich sytuacjach natychmiast pojawia się w sercu?

Otóż, okazuje się, że z perspektywy wiary, te wszystkie trudne sytuacje, równocześnie są pewnym wyzwaniem dla człowieka. Nawet cierpienie, zagrożenie zdrowia, dramat rozbitej rodziny, niezdany egzamin czy utrata pracy, z perspektywy wiary mogą okazać się punktem zwrotnym w życiu człowieka. Mogą stać się szansą na odnalezienie Boga. Z perspektywy całego ludzkiego życia sytuacje te często okazują się być raczej pewnym wyzwaniem, niż tragedią. Właśnie w sytuacjach trudnych, które paradoksalnie mogą

okazać się biblijnym 'talentem', Bóg oczekuje od człowieka wierności i działania.

Najczęstszy błąd ze strony człowieka polega jednak na tym, że widząc 'talenty trudne', najchętniej by je ukrył, schował, zepchnął w niepamięć i bezczynnie przeczekał, jak ostatni z trzech sług ewangelicznej przypowieści. W momencie bezczynności, inspirowanej lękiem o siebie, szybko pojawia się u człowieka zazdrość, narzekanie i oskarżenia. Zamiast być wiernym, dużo łatwiej jest człowiekowi uciekać od problemów w samotność, próbować zapomnieć o nich. Jedynie wierność i zaangażowanie człowieka w rozwijanie talentów, a przede wszystkim ufność Bogu może wydać owoce po naszym odejściu.

Warto zatem zapytać dziś siebie: jakie talenty mają obecnie wpływ na moją wierność i wytrwałość? Czy umiem dziękować Bogu nie tylko za te talenty, które niosą dobrobyt, lecz również za te, które mimo trudności, mogą okazać się dla mnie życiową szansą? Dziękuję za ciągłe wsparcie i hojność dla Parafii Św. Cyryla i Metodego. Życzę miłego tygodnia i niech Bóg błogosławi Was i Waszych najbliższych,






