From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners, For today's feast of Corpus Christi consider....

The importance of associating the Holy Eucharist with devotion to the Sacred Heart can scarcely be

overemphasized. Our instinctive Catholic sense tells us that no devotion is worth cultivation unless it is grounded on the solid dogmas of revelation and its roots go back to the tradition of the Apostolic Church. The question before us, therefore, is whether and to what extent the cultus of the Sacred Heart, actually rests on that sublime mystery of love which the Son of God instituted at the Last Supper when He gave us the Sacrament of the Altar. We begin to suspect that devotion to the Sacred Heart has some relation to the Holy Eucharist when we examine the words of Pope Pius XI: "As formerly Divine Goodness wished to exhibit to the human race, as it came from the Ark of Noe, a sign of the renewed covenant between them . . . so in our own troubled times, while that heresy held sway which is known as Jansenism, the most insidious of all heresies, enemy of the love of God and of filial affection for Him-for this heresy preached that God was not so much to be loved by us as a Father as to be feared as an unrelenting Judge—the most kind Jesus manifested to the nations His Sacred Heart."

At this point it is well to clarify a bit of Church history. Jansenism was really two heresies in one. On its doctrinal side it denied that Christ died for all men, and therefore pictured God very much as John Calvin, who said, "not all men are created with a similar destiny; but eternal life is foreordained for some, and eternal damnation for others." Christ did not die on the Cross, then, to save those whom God has arbitrarily decided should be lost.

In the opening paragraph of the first chapter of St Margarete Mary's memoirs, in answer to the question: "What do we mean by devotion to the Sacred Heart," we are told:

"The particular object of this devotion is the immense love of the Son of God which induced Him to deliver Himself up to death for us and to give Himself entirely to us in the Blessed Sacrament of the Altar. The thought of all the ingratitude and all the outrages which He has to receive in this state of immolated victim until the end of time did not prevent Him from operating this prodigy.

He preferred to expose Himself each day to the insults and opprobrium of men rather than be prevented from testifying by working the greatest of all miracles to what excess He loved us."







A powiedział on: "Jak niegdyś Boża Dobroć zapragnęła ukazać rodzajowi ludzkiemu, wychodzącemu z Arki Noego, znak odnowionego przymierza między nimi... tak i w naszych niespokojnych czasach, gdy panowała herezja znana jako Jansenizm — najbardziej podstępna ze wszystkich herezji, wróg miłości Bożej i synowskiego uczucia wobec Niego — albowiem herezja ta głosiła, że Boga nie należy kochać jak Ojca, lecz lękać się Go jako nieubłaganego Sędziego — najłaskawszy Jezus objawił narodom swoje Najświętsze Serce."

Należy tutaj wyjaśnić trochę historii Kościoła. Jansenizm był w rzeczywistości dwiema herezjami w jednej. Po stronie doktrynalnej zaprzeczał, że Chrystus umarł za wszystkich ludzi, a więc przedstawiał Boga bardzo podobnie jak Jan Kalwin, który powiedział: "Nie wszyscy ludzie są stworzeni z takim samym przeznaczeniem; lecz życie wieczne jest przeznaczone dla jednych, a wieczne potępienie dla innych." Chrystus zatem nie umarł na Krzyżu, aby zbawić tych, których Bóg arbitralnie zdecydował potępić.

W pierwszym akapicie pierwszego rozdziału wspomnień św. Małgorzaty Marii Alacoque, na pytanie: "Czym jest nabożeństwo do Najświętszego Serca?", czytamy: "Szczególnym przedmiotem tego nabożeństwa jest ogromna miłość Syna Bożego, która skłoniła Go do wydania samego siebie na śmierć za nas i do oddania się nam całkowicie w Najświętszym Sakramencie Ołtarza. Myśl o całej niewdzięczności i wszystkich zniewagach, które miał znosić w tym stanie ofiary aż do końca czasów, nie powstrzymała Go przed dokonaniem tego cudu.

Wolał narażać się każdego dnia na obelgi i hańbę ze strony ludzi, niż zaniechać ukazania przez największy z cudów, do jakiego stopnia nas umiłował."

not in a yoga class, but right here at Holy Mass. To keep this value in mind, the Marian Helpers Magazine this spring published an article called,

"When You Miss One Holy Communion"


- 1. You miss a personal visit with Jesus, author of all spiritual energy and of all holiness.
- 2. You lose a quota of sanctifying grace, which makes your soul more pleasing to God.
- 3. You lose a special increase of sanctifying grace, which entitles you to special help in times of temptation and in the discharge of your daily duties.
- 4. You lose a special opportunity of having all your venial sins wiped away.
- 5. You miss the special preserving influence which each Holy Communion confers against the fires of passion.
- 6. You miss the opportunity of having remitted a part, or all, of the temporal punishment due to your sins.
- 7. You lose the spiritual joy, the sweetness, and particular comfort that come from a fervent Holy Communion.
- 8. You lose part of the glory that your body might enjoy at its resurrection on the last day.



- 9. You lose the greater degree of glory you would possess in Heaven for all eternity.
- 10. You many lose: a) Complete victory over some fault or passion; b) Some particular grace long prayed for; c) The conversion or salvation of some soul; d) Deliverance of a relative or friend from Purgatory; e) many graces for others, both the living and the dead.

The article concluded, "Will a few extra minutes of sleep repay you for all those losses?"




