From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners,

In the parable in today's Gospel we hear the familiar words, "Master, did you not sow good seeds in the field?" Oddly, this causes us to consider an amazing thing happening today. One of the big mysteries in the Church in

recent years is the cancelation of the celebration of the beatification of one of America's most beloved bishops, Fulton Sheen. An international effort being led by Dr. Peter Howard, founder of the Fulton J. Sheen Institute is asking for signatures to a petition to reignite the Cause for Canonization of Fulton Sheen with a SET THE DATE FOR SHEEN campaign.

"A baby resurrection miracle has been approved and all aspects of Archbishop Fulton Sheen's tenure as Bishop of Rochester thoroughly investigated by Rome and the state of New York Attorney General's office with nothing found to impede his cause. Sheen, an Emmy Award-winning Catholic bishop, was a media pioneer, often characterized as America's first televangelist, and author of over 70 published works such as Treasure in Clay, Three to Get Married, Lift Up Your Heart, Life of Christ, and The World's First Love. He brought Christ to the masses and yet his date with destiny, the date to elevate him to sainthood, has been blocked." We applaud the many years of tireless work of the Diocese of Peoria and the Archbishop Fulton Sheen Foundation, to bring about this important goal.

Dr. Howard stated Sheen's universal impact and significance were demonstrated within the first 15 hours of the petition's launch as signatures came in from all six inhabited continents. Ven. Fulton J. Sheen was scheduled to be beatified in December 2019, when just weeks before the anticipated Peoria event, the beatification was abruptly canceled with no explanation from Catholic officials. Everything required canonically by the Congregation for the Causes of Saints for Sheen to be Blessed has been completed since 2014. The legal drama over his body was concluded in 2019. At that same time, on 5 July 2019, Pope Francis issued a decree verifying a miracle through the intercession of Venerable Sheen. That cleared the way for a date to be set for the ceremonial Mass during which Fulton Sheen would be declared 'Blessed.' Pope Francis moved quickly at that point to schedule that Mass for 21 December 2019 in Peoria.


This is why I urge all who are reading this article to sign the petition to "Set the Date". Sheen's

cause and significance extend way beyond a single diocese. Sheen's cause is for the whole Church. Who better to reignite that spark and fan it into flame than the lay movement Fulton Sheen himself prophesied would save the Church in our times. If you are unfamiliar with him do yourself the favor of going to YouTube and type in Bishop Fulton Sheen. You'll find many of his talks which are sure to inspire. Go to www.fultonsheenmovement.org to sign the petition.







Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie,

W dzisiejszej Ewangelii słyszymy znajome nam słowa: "Panie, czy nie posiałeś na swoim polu dobrego ziarna?" Co dziwne, skłania nas to do rozważenia niesamowitej rzeczy, która ma miejsce dzisiaj. Jedną z wielkich tajemnic

Kościoła w ostatnich latach jest odwołanie obchodów beatyfikacji jednego z najbardziej ukochanych biskupów Ameryki, Fultona Sheena. Międzynarodowa inicjatywa kierowana przez dr. Petera Howarda, założyciela Instytutu Fultona J. Sheena, prosi o podpisy pod petycją o wznowienie procesu kanonizacyjnego Fultona Sheena za pomocą kampanii USTAL DATĘ SHEEN.

.. Cud zmartwychwstania dziecka został zatwierdzony, a wszystkie aspekty kadencji arcybiskupa Fultona Sheena jako biskupa Rochester zostały dokładnie zbadane przez Rzym i biuro prokuratora generalnego stanu Nowy Jork i nie znaleziono niczego, co mogłoby przeszkodzić jego sprawie. Sheen, zdobywca nagrody Emmy biskupa katolickiego, był pionierem mediów, często określanym jako pierwszy amerykański teleewangelista jak i również autorem ponad 70 opublikowanych prac, takich jak Skarb w Glinie (Treasure in Clay), Troje do Ślubu (Three to Get Married), Wesprzej Serce (Lift Up Your Heart), Życie Chrystusa (Life of Christ) i Pierwsza Miłość Świata (World's First Love). Sheen przyniósł Chrystusa narodom, a jednak jego data wyniesienia go do świętości została zablokowana". Z wielkim szacunkiem chylimy czoło przed wieloletnią niestrudzoną pracą diecezji Peoria i Fundacją Arcybiskupa Fultona Sheena, aby osiągnąć ten ważny cel.

Dr. Howard stwierdził, że uniwersalny wpływ i znaczenie Sheena zostały wykazane w ciągu pierwszych 15 godzin od uruchomienia petycji, ponieważ napłynęty podpisy ze wszystkich sześciu zamieszkałych kontynentów. Beatyfikację Fultona J. Sheena zaplanowano na grudzień 2019 r., kiedy na kilka tygodni przed przewidywanym wydarzeniem w Peorii beatyfikacja została nagle odwołana bez wyjaśnienia ze strony urzędników katolickich. Od 2014 roku zakończono wszystko, czego kanonicznie wymagała Kongregacja Spraw Kanonizacyjnych, aby Sheen został błogosławionym. Dramat prawny wokół jego ciała zakończył się w 2019 roku. W tym samym czasie, 5 lipca 2019 roku, papież Franciszek wydał dekret weryfikujący cud za wstawiennictwem czcigodnego Sheena. To otworzyło drogę do ustalenia daty uroczystej Mszy, podczas której Fulton Sheen zostanie ogłoszony "błogosławionym". Papież Franciszek szybko przystąpił do tego punktu, aby

zaplanować Mszę św. na 21 grudnia 2019 r. W Peorii, która jednak została zatrzymana.

Dlatego zachęcam wszystkich czytających ten artykuł do podpisania petycji "Ustal datę". Sprawa i znaczenie Sheena wykraczają daleko poza pojedynczą diecezję. Sprawa Sheena dotyczy całego Kościoła. Któż mógłby lepiej rozpalić tę iskrę i rozniecić płomień niż świecki ruch, o którym sam Fulton Sheen prorokował, że uratuje Kościół w naszych czasach. Jeśli go nie znasz, zrób sobie przysługę i poszukaj w YouTube biskupa Fultona Sheena. Znajdziesz wiele jego przemówień, które z pewnością Cię zainspirują. Wejdź na www.fultonsheenmovement.org aby podpisać petycję. Dziękuję, wiedz że "Bóg Cię kocha".




