From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners,

To know who we are requires that we know our history. To know ourselves as Catholics is to know Catholic history. Although understanding and interpreting

correctly Papal Encyclicals can be quite a challenge, it is well worth exploring these important teachings of the past. Let's go back to 1832, just one year before Fr Irenaeus St Cyr began St James. Pope Gregory XVI wrote, Mirari Vos, aka: "On Liberalism". He calls out "insolent and factious men" from both the halls of civil government and Catholic institutions. This was the time of Napolean's attempt to take over all of Europe. Gregory XVI would have certainly felt like the early Popes under such tyrants as the Roman Emperor Diocletian since both of his immediate predecessors, Pius VI and Pius VII were kidnapped and imprisoned by the French army as they demanded a more "liberal" government and church. The very popular Catholic Abbot Félicité LaMennais who praised the modern liberal trends often attacked the Papacy. Gregory XVI quotes Luke 22:53 comparing these times to the "powers of darkness that winnow the elect like wheat." Certainly, the errors of LaMennais would have cut to his heart so deeply because Gregory himself was the Abbott of large monastery before becoming Pope.

Many modern Catholics will dismiss Gregory's attack against "liberalism". They only see one side of the narrative. That side was real enough, but it must be noted that it was not the whole story. Their dismissal of Encyclicals like Mirari Vos is based on the issue of the "Papal States". The common contemporary blacklisting of folks like Gregory XVI and praising of prelates like LeMennais is righteous, they say because it shows that the Church was wrong to fight for control over property. Their attitude is similar to any critic of Catholicsm who justifies their abandoning the practice of the faith because the Vatican has too much wealth. True enough, Saints like St Francis of Assisi, John Vianney and Mother Theresa are always needed to bring authentic renewal to the Church. But what churchmen like LaMennais fail to see is the fact that their support of the liberalization of governments

from monarchies to republics failed to halt the liberalization of moral principles from the long compilation of Christian morals to what could only be called the pagan moral principles of hedonism. Pope Gregory rightly saw, that if the Church was stripped of all its authority over temporal things, then only the "hedonistic" civil authorities would rule over temporal matters. Only the ruling elite would control worldly matters. Catholic wisdom knows better. We should all see that when immoral people oversee the economy widespread poverty follows. Sad to say, too many today still don't get it.

DISCIPLE MAKER INDEX SURVEY

Concluding the report on St James' results from the Chicago Archdiocesan-sponsored Disciple Index Survey which asked questions about an individual's journey of discipleship & how the parish and the pastor rated in supporting that journey. The survey was taken in 72 dioceses across the country, netting ~650,000 individual responses, 137 were James-ers. Results show that St James is ahead of the average in every category, and a leader across numerous metrics.

Some highlights from the responses submitted about conversations about faith and religious education:

- 100% would recommend the parish's CCD to a friend
- 93% believe the parish provides high-quality events
 & other opportunities to which they can invite people
- 93% believe the parish helps them to recognize how God is working in their life
- 92% believe the parish grows their confidence in the Church's teachings so they can answer other's questions

Following are opportunities for improvement & growth:

- Fewer than half of respondents regularly (at least monthly) invite someone to join them at Mass or an activity at the parish
- Our parishioners could use assistance to feel more comfortable inviting someone to consider a vocation to religious life
- We should equip our parishioners to share their personal witness story more than they already do
- We should consider ways to increase participation in volunteer opportunities





Lenten Regulations (Ash Wednesday, to the Paschal Triduum)

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday

and on all the Fridays of Lent. Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Those who have a medical condition in which fasting may be considered harmful, are not obliged. The special Paschal fast, as well as abstinence, are prescribed for Good Friday and encouraged for Holy Saturday.




Collection & Burning of Palms

Rodzina Ulmów wzorem wiary i patriotyzmu





Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie,

Aby poznać kim tak naprawdę jesteśmy, musimy znać naszą historię. Poznanie i zrozumienie siebie jako katolików to poznanie historii katolickiej. Chociaż zrozumienie i poprawne interpretowanie encyklik papieskich może być wyzwaniem,

warto zgłębiać te ważne nauki przeszłości. Wróćmy do roku 1832, zaledwie rok przed rozpoczęciem przez ojca Irenaeusa St Cyr parafii św. Jakuba. Papież Grzegorz XVI napisał "Mirari Vos", znane również jako "O liberalizmie". Wywołuje on "bezczelnych i kłótliwych ludzi" zarówno z sal rządu cywilnego, jak i instytucji katolickich. To był czas próby Napoleona, próby przejęcia kontroli nad całą Europą. Grzegorz XVI z pewnością czuł się podobnie jak wczesni papieże pod rządami takich tyranów jak cesarz rzymski Dioklecjan, ponieważ zarówno jego bezpośredni poprzednicy, Pius VI, jak i Pius VII, zostali porwani i uwięzieni przez armię francuską, gdy domagali się bardziej "liberalnego" rządu i kościoła. Bardzo popularny katolicki opat Félicité LaMennais, który chwaląc nowoczesne trendy liberalne, często atakował papieża. Grzegorz XVI gdy cytował Łukasza 22:53, porównał te czasy do "mocy ciemności, które przesiewają wybranych jak pszenicę". Bez wątpienia błędy LaMennais dosięgnęły go głęboko, ponieważ sam Grzegorz był opatem dużego klasztoru przed objęciem pontyfikatu.

Współcześni katolicy często odrzucają atak Grzegorza przeciwko "liberalizmowi" widząc tylko jedną stronę narracji. Jest ona dla nich wystarczająco realna, ale należy zauważyć, że to nie była kompletna historia. Odrzucenie przez nich encyklik, takich jak "Mirari Vos", opiera się na kwestii "Państwa Papieskiego". Współczesne czarne listy ludzi takich jak Grzegorz XVI a z przeciwnej strony chwalenie dostojników takich jak LeMennais są uzasadnione. Twierdzą, że ukazuje to Kościół w świetle błędu, który walczył o kontrolę nad własnością. Ich postawa jest podobna do postawy każdego krytyka katolicyzmu, który uzasadnia porzucenie praktyki wiary, ponieważ Watykan posiada zbyt wiele dóbr materialnych. Przyznam tutaj rację. Jednak, zawsze potrzebni są święci, tacy jak św. Franciszek z Asyżu, Jan Maria Vianney czy Matka Teresa, aby przynieśli autentyczną odnowę Kościołowi. EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL 2023-24 IN OUR PARISH

Comments from You - Our Parishioners - on this Year of Eucharistic Revival

On being attentive at Mass: "I am a person who is easily distracted, and I have to deliberately pay attention

at Mass so I do not become a hypocrite. I look forward to the part of the Eucharistic Prayer when the priest says 'Lift up your hearts' and I think, 'where else are our hearts supposed to be? Aren't they already supposed to be lifted up?' So, I am glad that we the people respond, 'We have lifted them up to the Lord.' Those moments can be like a 'wake-up call' for those who were daydreaming so we can join with the angels to sing. 'Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of Hosts. Heaven and earth are full of your glory.' Those words, and the bells, remind me to lay aside whatever is weighing down on my heart, so I can lift my heart up to the Lord."

Our parish is already there: "I understand that many parishes in the U.S. may have members who do not believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. But I believe that we here at St. Cyril's and St. James already know, adore, and love Our Lord in the Eucharist. Just look at the way people genuflect or bow at the altar, the reverence with which we receive Holy Communion, the number of people who attend daily Mass and pray in our Adoration Chapel. I think we really 'get it' here. The virtue of piety is present in each celebrant and most of the participants. That is what makes me happy to be part of this parish; that we really celebrate Jesus in the Eucharist."

Yes, there is revival in my heart: "Thank you for reminding us of the National Eucharistic Revival. It has helped me realize what I am missing when I skip Mass. I try to get to Mass every Sunday, but don't always plan it in ahead as a priority. Even though I could not attend the Bible Study on the Eucharist, I am now trying to get to Mass each Sunday. I am kind of like having my own personal Eucharistic Revival, just prioritizing Mass each weekend. I know I am spiritually fed by the Body and Blood of Jesus, and I resolve in 2024 to prove to God that I love Him in return by attending Mass every Saturday night or Sunday this year.
