

## Dear Parishioners,

From our earliest years, we have been brought up to value justice. Playing fair is part of our earliest training in life. That's why when we hear today's Gospel, the Parable of the Laborers in the Field, we immediately think, "That's just not

right. The guys who worked all day have a good argument. They should have been paid more."

But the parable isn't really about who should get paid what. The parable is about God. He is the Good Employer, the Divine Employer. This parable is not about the workers, it is about God who offers His grace to people at various times in their lives. That's what the parable of the laborers in the vineyard is really about. God's grace comes to different people at different times and in different ways. And that includes every one of us. Perhaps some of us feel that we have not been the person we could and should be. The Gospel encourages us not to give up on ourselves. God never gives up on us. We can always start new, whether we have just been lukewarm Christians or whether we have been at war with God. Not only does God refuse to hold us to our past, He forgives us through confession and transforms us to become vehicles of conversion for others. The Divine Employer does not want us wasting any more time. Even if we are pretty well advanced in age, and the day is drawing to a close, He still has work for us to do. He needs us, and He wants us, no matter what our pasts have been.

- Progress Reports for the first trimester will be going home on Thursday, September 28th.


Finally, everyone from grades K-8 completed the first "iReady" online assessment. The data obtained will help teachers identify areas of strength and areas which may need more work.
