#### From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners,

It belongs to the liberal man to part with things. Hence, liberality is also called open-handedness (largitas), because that which is open does not withhold things but parts of them.

The term "liberality" seems also to allude to this, since when a man quits hold of a thing, he frees it (liberat), so to speak, from his keeping and ownership, and shows his mind to be free of attachment thereto. Now, those things which are the subject of a man's free-handedness towards others are the goods he possesses, which are denoted by the term "money." Therefore, the proper matter of liberality is money. Liberality depends not on the quantity given, but on the heart of the giver. Now, the heart of the giver is disposed according to the passions of love and desire, and consequently, those of pleasure and sorrow, towards the things given. Hence, the interior passions are the immediate matter of liberality, while exterior money is the object of those same passions.

Now, the use of money consists in parting with it. For the acquisition of money is like generation rather than use: while the keeping of money, in so far as it is directed to facilitate the use of money, is like a habit. Now in parting with a thing—for instance, when we throw something—the farther we put it away the greater the force (virtus) employed. Hence, parting with money by giving it to others proceeds from a greater virtue than when we spend it on ourselves. But it is proper to a virtue as such to tend to what is more perfect, since "virtue is a kind of perfection." Therefore, a liberal man is praised chiefly for giving. — St. Thomas Aquinas, Summa Theologiae II:2:117

And since Aug 4 is the feast of St. John Vianney, here's a bit of his great wisdom:

"Envy, my children, follows pride; whoever is envious is proud. See, envy comes to us from Hell; the devils having sinned through pride, sinned also through envy, envying our glory, our happiness. Why do we envy the happiness and the goods of others? Because we are proud; we should like to be the sole possessors of talents, riches, of the esteem and love of all the world! We hate our equals, because they are our equals; our inferiors, from the fear that they may equal us; our superiors, because they are above us.

The most Holy Virgin places herself between her Son and us. The greater sinners we are, the more

tenderness and compassion does she feel for us. The child that has cost its mother most tears is the dearest to her heart. Does not a mother always run to the help of the weakest and the most exposed to danger? Is not a physician in the hospital most attentive to those who are most seriously ill? The Heart of Mary is so tender towards us, that those of all the mothers in the world put together are like a piece of ice in comparison to hers." See how good the Holy Virgin is!






#### A Note From Cardinal Blase Cupich

The Church teaches that receiving Holy Communion is not a private action but a communal one, as the very word "communion" implies. For that reason, the norm established by the Holy See for the universal Church and approved by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops is for the faithful to process together as an expression of their coming forward as the Body of Christ and to receive Holy

Communion standing. Processions are an ancient practice of the Church and have been part of the liturgy from the earliest days, assisting the faithful to always keep in mind that we are a pilgrim people, making our way together to the fulness of the heavenly banquet Christ has prepared for us. We process into the church. We process up to bring the gifts. We process to receive Holy Communion. We process out to carry the Lord into the world.

Nothing should be done to impede this sacred ritual of receiving communion or diminish its powerful symbol by disrupting an important moment by which the faithful, in processing together, express their faith that they are called to become the very Body of Christ they receive. Certainly, reverence can and should be expressed by bowing before the reception of Holy Communion, but no one should engage in a gesture that calls attention to oneself or disrupts the flow of the procession by assuming another posture. That would be contrary to the norms and tradition of the church, which all the faithful are urged to respect and observe.

#### Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie,

Cechą człowieka szlachetnego (liberalnego) jest to, że potrafi rozstawać się z rzeczami. Dlatego też hojność (liberalitas) nazywana jest również szczodrością (largitas), ponieważ to, co jest otwarte, nie zatrzymuje rzeczy, lecz się

nimi dzieli. Termin "hojność" nawiązuje również do tego, ponieważ gdy człowiek puszcza coś wolno, niejako "uwalnia" (liberat) to ze swego posiadania i opieki, ukazując, że jego serce jest wolne od przywiązania do tej rzeczy. Rzeczami, którymi człowiek może swobodnie dzielić się z innymi, są dobra, które posiada, a które oznacza się ogólnie mianem "pieniędzy". Dlatego właściwym przedmiotem hojności są pieniądze. Hojność nie zależy od ilości ofiarowanych rzeczy, ale od serca ofiarodawcy. Serce zaś ofiarodawcy kształtuje się według namiętności miłości i pragnienia, a co za tym idzie — również przyjemności i smutku względem darowanych rzeczy. Stąd wewnętrzne namiętności są najbliższym przedmiotem hojności, podczas gdy zewnętrzne pieniądze są przedmiotem tychże namiętności.

Użycie pieniędzy polega na ich rozdawaniu. Zdobywanie pieniędzy jest bardziej podobne do aktu "zrodzenia" niż do użytkowania, podczas gdy przechowywanie pieniędzy — o ile służy późniejszemu ich wykorzystaniu — jest jakby nawykiem. Teraz zaś, gdy rozstajemy się z rzeczą — na przykład wyrzucając ją — im dalej ją odrzucimy, tym większa siła (virtus) została użyta. Tak więc rozdawanie pieniędzy innym wynika z większej cnoty niż wydawanie ich na siebie. A ponieważ istotą cnoty jest dążenie do tego, co doskonalsze — "cnota jest bowiem pewną doskonałością" — dlatego człowiek hojny jest przede wszystkim chwalony za to, że daje. —St. Thomas Aquinas, Summa Theologiae II:2:117

Tak więc z okazji przypadającego 4 sierpnia wspomnienia św. Jana Marii Vianneya podzielę się z Wami odrobiną jego mądrości:

Zazdrość, moje dzieci, idzie za pychą; kto jest zazdrosny, jest pyszny. Widzicie, zazdrość pochodzi z piekła; diabły, które zgrzeszyły przez pychę, zgrzeszyły też przez zazdrość — zazdrościły naszej chwały, naszego szczęścia. Dlaczego zazdrościmy szczęścia i dóbr innym? Bo jesteśmy pyszni; chcielibyśmy być jedynymi posiadaczami talentów, bogactw, uznania i miłości całego świata! Nienawidzimy równym nam, dlatego, ze są nam równi; naszych niższych, bo w strachu myślimy, że mogą nam dorównać; naszych wyższych, bo są ponad nami.

Najświętsza Dziewica stawia się między swoim Synem a nami. Im większymi grzesznikami jesteśmy, tym więcej czułości i współczucia ma dla nas. Dziecko, które kosztowało matkę najwięcej łez, jest jej najdroższe. Czyż matka nie biegnie zawsze na pomoc temu dziecku, które jest najsłabsze i najbardziej narażone na niebezpieczeństwo? Czyż lekarz w szpitalu nie troszczy się najbardziej o tych, którzy są najciężej chorzy? Serce Maryi jest tak czułe wobec nas, że serca wszystkich matek świata razem wzięte są jak kawałek lodu w porównaniu z Jej sercem. Zobaczcie, jaka dobra jest Najświętsza Dziewica!


