From the desk of Father Koys
Dear Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, we hear Our Lord talking about a King who gives a great banquet. But many refuse to come. Those who were first invited He declares, were not worthy to come.

They didn't realize how much the King wished to celebrate together with them. The King's invitation wasn't that important. They had better things to do. How can we not take this to be a reminder of our own attitudes about our Catholic faith? Life is all about priorities. Jesus wants us all to make not only Holy Mass a high priority but our participation in all the many good works of our church.

In G.K. Chesterton's book, *Everlasting Man*, he compares the ancient world's pagan religions to the revolutionary faith we call Catholicism. Paganism was characterized by "polytheism" or the belief that there were many gods. G.K. says, "Polytheism was never to the pagan what Catholicism is to the Catholic. Paganism was never a view of the universe that could satisfy all sides of life. Catholicism is (or should be for us) a complete and complex truth that has something to say about everything. Paganism was a spirituality that satisfied only one side of the soul of man. The wonderful mythical stories of the gods and goddesses satisfied one mood or spiritual need of the common man (or woman). The ordinary man wonders whether there are powers higher than human powers that control our lives. He wonders how the things we take for granted, like our nations, our families, and the stars above us came to be. The pagan world with its myths gave at least some satisfactory answers to these questions of the soul. But Catholicism G.K. insists takes us much farther than this. Accepting Catholicism is like accepting the invitation of the King in the gospel. We should not turn to religion only when we are in the mood for religion. Are there any "Chreesters" (people who only come to Mass on Christmas and Easter) listening?

Now, when it comes to excuses for missing Mass, especially among our young people, sports ranks high on the list. Please don't get me wrong here. I do love sports and sports can be a great arena for building character and living the virtues of life. But when commitments to the team take the higher priority over our commitment to our Catholic faith we fall into the same trap of the polytheists of old. And it's not only time that matters. It's financial commitment too. "A study conducted last summer by TD Ameritrade found that parents whose children participated in highly competitive or elite teams run by a non-school organization were spending on average \$500 to \$1,000 per month, per

child. More specifically, travel baseball averages out to \$3,700 per year but can be upward of \$8,000 if they opt for extra training services and play in out-of-state tournaments. High-end volleyball teams with travel will easily average \$8,000 to \$10,000 per year while less competitive, more regional club programs are usually \$1,500." (from US Today)

Most of us in modern America need to heed Chesterton's call to embrace fully our Catholic faith. Of all the things that give us our identity, being a faithful Catholic, and not a "cafeteria Catholic" scores a touchdown.

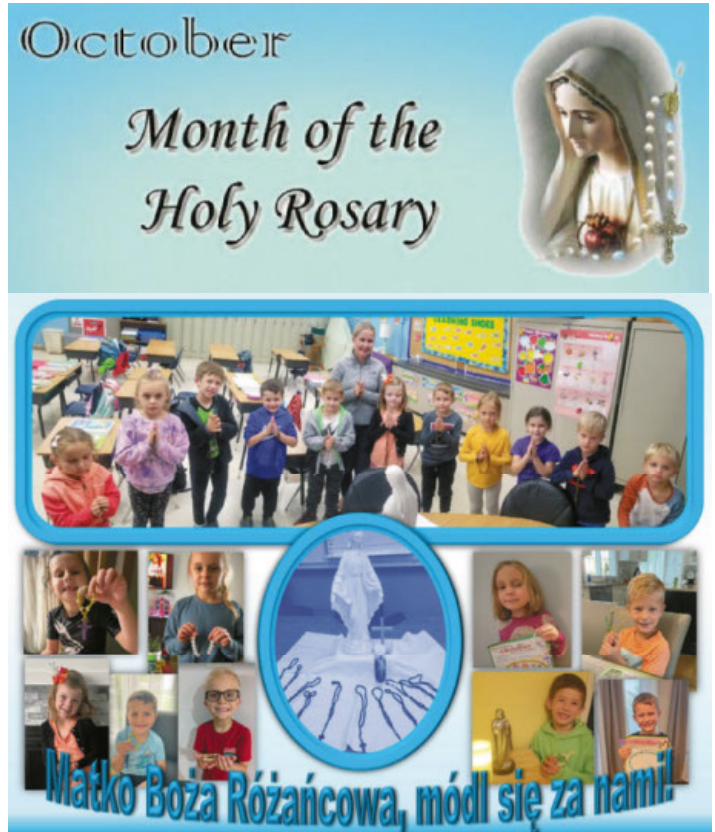

Lemont Catholic Anointing of the Sick Bilingual Mass

On **Saturday, November 11th**, SS. Cyril & Methodius Parish will celebrate the Anointing of the Sick at the **11 AM Mass. This will be a bilingual (English-Polish) Mass.**

We extend an invitation to those in our Lemont Catholic Family who feel that the Celebration of Anointing will provide help for them in sickness and aging of their bodies.

In the past, the anointing was done near the time of death. Theology today understands anointing as the Sacrament of the Sick rather than at the time of approaching death. The Anointing of the Sick is the prayer of Christ and His Church for the physical and spiritual health of the sick person.

Who may be anointed?

- ❖ A sick person may be anointed before he/she undergoes surgery, whether or not the surgery is serious.
- ❖ Persons with chronic illness.
- ❖ Older persons, even if they are not suffering from dangerous illness.
- ❖ Mentally disabled persons and chemically dependent persons.
- ❖ A sick child may be anointed in order to be comforted and uplifted by the Sacrament.

After the Mass, there will be a luncheon for all those who attend in our Parish Life Building. 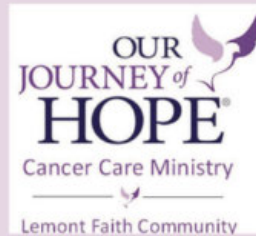

Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie,

W dzisiejszej Ewangelii widzimy, jak nasz Pan mówi o Królu, który urządza wielkie przyjęcie. Jednak wielu odmawia przyjęcia. Ci, którzy zostali najpierw zaproszeni, okazują się niegodni przybycia. Nie zdawali sobie sprawy, jak bardzo Król chce

świętować razem z nimi. Zaproszenie Króla nie było dla nich ważne. Mieli ważniejsze rzeczy do zrobienia. Jak możemy nie potraktować tego jako przypomnienia o naszych własnych postawach wobec naszej wiary katolickiej? Życie polega na priorytetach. Jezus chce, abyśmy wszyscy uczynili nie tylko Mszę Św. wysokim priorytetem, ale także nasze zaangażowanie we wszystkie dobre dzieła naszego kościoła.

W książce G.K. Chestertona, "Wieczny Człowiek", porównuje on pogańskie religie starożytnego świata z rewolucyjną wiarą, którą nazywamy katolicką. Pogaństwo było charakteryzowane "politeizmem" czyli wiarą w wiele bogów. G.K. mówi: "Politeizm nigdy nie był dla poganina tym, czym katolicka wiara jest dla katolika. Pogaństwo nigdy nie było światopoglądem, który mógłby zaspokoić wszystkie strony życia. Katolicka wiara jest (lub powinna być dla nas) kompletną i złożoną prawdą, która ma obszerne znaczenie. Pogaństwo było duchowością, która zaspokajała tylko jedną stronę duszy człowieka. Zwyczajny człowiek zastanawia się, czy istnieją siły wyższe od ludzkich, które kontrolują nasze życie. Zastanawia się, jak rzeczy, które uważamy za oczywiste, takie jak narody, nasze rodziny i gwiazdy nad nami, powstały. Świat pogański ze swoimi mitami dawał przynajmniej jakieś satysfakcjonujące odpowiedzi na te pytania duszy. Natomiast, G.K. upiera się, że katolicka wiara zabiera nas znacznie dalej niż to. Przyjęcie katolickiej wiary to jak przyjęcie zaproszenia Króla w ewangelii. Nie powinniśmy zwracać się ku religii tylko wtedy, gdy mamy na to ochotę czy potrzebę. Przychodzi mi teraz na myśl pytanie, czy słuchając tego jacyś "Chreesterzy" (osoby, które przychodzą na Mszę tylko w Boże Narodzenie i Wielkanoc)?

Natomiast, jeśli chodzi o wymówki odnośnie opuszczania Mszy Świętej, zwłaszcza wśród naszych młodych ludzi, sport zajmuje wysokie miejsce na liście. Proszę mnie źle nie zrozumieć. Kocham sporty i sport może być doskonałą areną do budowania charakteru i realizacji celów życia. Ale gdy zobowiązania wobec drużyny stają się ważniejsze niż nasze zobowiązanie wobec naszej wiary katolickiej, wpadamy w tę samą pułapkę co starożytni politeiści. Chodzi tutaj nie tylko o czas, ale także o zaangażowanie finansowe. "Badania przeprowadzone ubiegłego roku przez TD Ameritrade wykazały, że rodzice, których dzieci uczestniczą w bardzo konkurencyjnych lub elitarnych zespołach prowadzonych przez organizacje pozaszkolne, wydają średnio od 500 do 1,000 dolarów miesięcznie na jedno dziecko. Tak na przykład, baseball z podróżami kosztuje średnio 3,700 dolarów rocznie,

ale może wynieść nawet 8,000 dolarów, jeśli zdecydują się na dodatkowe usługi szkoleniowe i udział w turniejach międzystanowych. Koszt wysokiej klasy drużyny siatkarskiej z podróżami swobodnie sięga od 8,000 do 10,000 dolarów rocznie, podczas gdy mniej konkurencyjne, bardziej regionalne kluby kosztują zwykle 1,500 dolarów" (źródło: USA Today).

Większość z nas we współczesnej Ameryce powinna posłuchać wezwania Chestertona, aby w pełni przyjąć naszą wiarę katolicką. Spośród wszystkich rzeczy, które nadają nam naszą tożsamość, bycie wiernym katolikiem, a nie "katolikiem kawiarnianym", zdobywa zwycięstwo.
