**Dear Parishioners,**

The First Reading of the Mass briefly shows us how the Christian community lived after the marvelous events of the Resurrection of Christ. It shows us that, as the community grew, its problems also grew.

Friction among them was becoming more frequent. Some of them began to complain, saying that injustice and discrimination existed in the community. The new Christians who spoke Greek complained about those who spoke Hebrew, saying that in the daily distribution, their widows were not being taken care of. This shows us that discrimination and favoritism existed then, as now, in communities. More than twenty centuries later, there continue to be problems in many Christian communities. The reason continues to be that some want to be more important than others.

The Apostles saw that some members of the community were looking down on others, treating them like second-class Christians. This angered the Apostles, and they condemned this discrimination. To resolve the problem, which was a major one, they reorganized the community. They could not neglect the Word of God to worry about administration. So they started what we today call the Diaconate.

The Apostles chose men of faith who were wise and full of the Holy Spirit to serve the members of the community by administering the common goods and doing away with injustices. Among them was St. Stephen, who was chosen to be a deacon and was martyred later on for his faith and good work. On behalf of the Apostles themselves, the work of the first deacons was to teach the early Church to respect the dignity of each human being, not to discriminate against others, and, most importantly, not to believe that we are better than other members of the community and, in a special way, to serve others in whatever way we can.

Even though it is true that there has always been injustice in the world, I don't think that I am wrong when I say that in these times it has reached enormous proportions. Inside and outside of our Christian communities, there are many people who are always doing things to help their neighbors. But serving others, without being noticed, does not interest many people. The Church teaches us that

those who act that way do not know anything about Gospel values. A person who lives the Gospel as Christ said, or as closely as possible, clearly knows that the Lord commanded us to serve others as the first deacons did. Their spirit of giving was so great that more than just St. Stephen suffered martyrdom for Christ.

We are all chosen to minister to others, and we have our example in Christ. He always loved the weakest. He never discriminated. Nor did he show favoritism, and he always lived truthfully, in word and deed. Will we ever learn to be, even just a little, like Christ? Why don't we understand that serving others for Christ is uplifting? As Catholics, and as members of our parish, let us understand that we are all members of one Christian family and that God created us equal. Through our faith, we know that each person is important to God. Let us ask the Lord to give us the humility to practice solidarity with others, to learn to help those in need, even if this means sacrifice—sacrifice for the love of God.

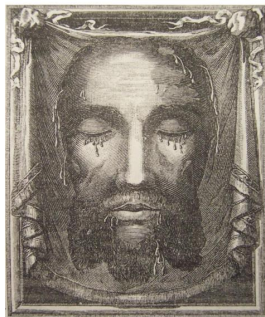

### **Drodzy Parafianie,**

Dzisiejsze pierwsze czytanie pokrótce pokazuje nam jak żyła wspólnota chrześcijańska po cudownych wydarzeniach Zmartwychwstania Chrystusa oraz przedstawia, jak rosły problemy wraz z rozrastaniem się społeczności chrześcijańskiej. Spory wśród nich stawały się coraz częstsze, a niektórzy mówili, że niesprawiedliwość i dyskryminacja istnieją w ich wspólnocie. Nowi Chryścijanie mówiący po Grecku szemrali przeciwko Hebrajczykom, że przy codziennym rozdawaniu jałmużny zaniedbywano ich wdowy. Widzimy, że już w tamtych czasach w społecznościach istniały dyskryminacja i kumoterstwo. Ponad dwadzieścia wieków później, nadal występują problemy w wielu wspólnotach chrześcijańskich.

Apostołowie zauważyli, że niektórzy członkowie wspólnoty patrzyli na innych z góry, traktując ich jak chrześcijan drugiej klasy. To ich rozgniewało i potępiło tę dyskryminację. W celu rozwiązania problemu dokonali zmian we wspólnocie chrześcijańskiej. Nie mogli oni zaniedbywać Słowa Bożego, zajmując się sprawami administracyjnymi, więc rozpoczęli coś, co obecnie nazywamy Diakonatem.

Apostołowie wybrali ludzi wiary, którzy byli mądrzy i napelnieni Duchem Świętym, aby służyli członkom wspólnoty, rozporządzając wspólnymi dobrami i usuwając niesprawiedliwości. Wśród nich był także św. Szczepan, który został wybrany na Diakona, a później za swoją wiarę i oddaną posługę zginął śmiercią męczeńską. We wczesnym Kościele pierwsi diakoni, w imieniu samych Apostołów, nauczali poszanowania godności każdego człowieka, aby nie dyskryminować innych i co najważniejsze, niesądzenia, że jesteśmy lepsi od innych członków wspólnoty oraz, w szczególnie sposób, służyć innym, w każdy możliwy sposób.

Mimo prawdy, że niesprawiedliwość istniała na świecie od zawsze, myślę, że nie myślę się, mówiąc, iż w obecnych czasach przybrała niesamowite rozmiary. Wewnątrz i na zewnątrz naszej wspólnoty chrześcijańskiej jest wiele ludzi, którzy ciągle coś robią, aby pomóc swoim bliźnim. Jednak pomoc innym bez rozgłosu nie interesuje wielu ludzi. Kościół naucza nas, że ludzie postępujący w ten sposób nie wiedzą nic na temat wartości zawartych w Ewangelii. Osoba żyjąca Ewangelią, tak jak nauczał Chrystus, lub możliwie najpełniej, dobrze wie, że Pan nakazał nam służyć innym tak jak to czynili pierwsi

diakoni. Ich duch dawania był tak wielki, że wielu jeszcze poza św. Szczepanem poniosło śmierć męczeńską dla Chrystusa.

My wszyscy zostaliśmy powołani, aby służyć innym, a naszym przykładem jest Chrystus. On zawsze miłował najsłabszych, nigdy nie dyskryminował ani nie faworyzował, zawsze żył zgodnie z prawdą w słowie i czynie. Czy kiedykolwiek nauczymy się być chociaż trochę podobni do Chrystusa? Dlaczego nie możemy zrozumieć, że służba innym w imię Chrystusa wzmacnia? Jako Katolicy i członkowie wspólnoty parafialnej, prosimy, aby było nam dane zrozumieć, że wszyscy jesteśmy członkami jednej chrześcijańskiej rodziny, oraz, że Bóg stworzył nas równymi. Przez wiarę, wiemy, że każdy człowiek jest dla Boga ważny. Prosimy Pana, aby obdarzył nas pokorą do praktykowania jedności z innymi, nauczył pomagać potrzebującym nawet jeśli oznaczałoby to poświęcenie — ofiarę z miłości do Boga.

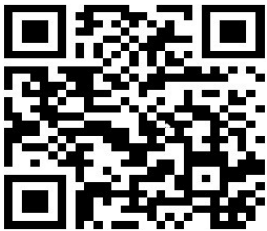
