This past Friday we had our final Lenten fish fry. Thank you to John Tracy, his great volunteers, our maintenance team, and everyone who attended for making them successful!

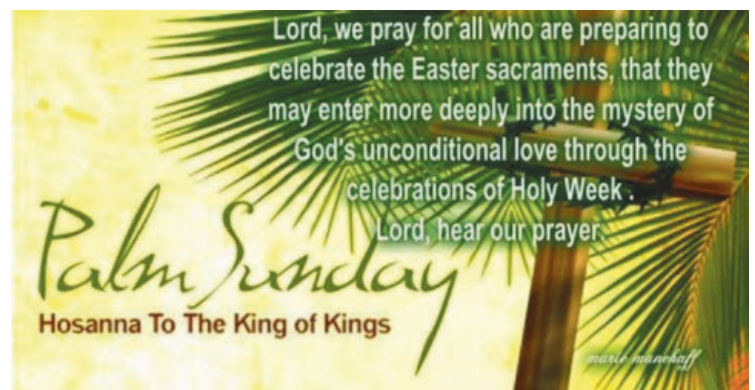
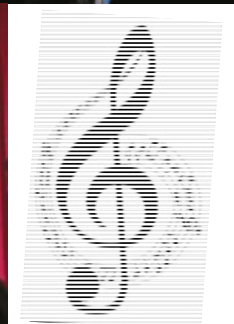
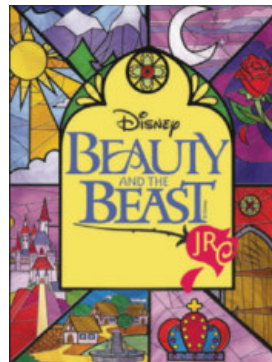

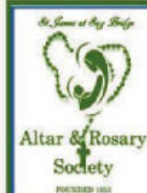
Holy Week Fasting & Abstinence

If possible, the fast on Good Friday should be continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

Good Friday Collection March 29th Collection for the Holy Land

Every year on Good Friday, a collection is taken up in Catholic Churches to support the work of the Franciscans working in the Holy Land. Christians there rely heavily on the help that comes to them from this worldwide collection.



Good Friday Regulations ~

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older. Fasting is to be observed on Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age and not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Those who have a medical condition in which fasting may be considered harmful, are not obliged. The special Paschal fast, as well as abstinence, are prescribed for Good Friday and encouraged for Holy Saturday.
