From the desk of Father Kloys

Dear Parishioners,

With Columbus Day tomorrow and the Gospel singing the praises of a foreigner who recognizes the greatness of Jesus Christ's power to heal, I can't help but share a very key point I just heard about our precious faith.

The Epoch Times replayed an interview that Charlie Kirk did with a student. The question the student posed was, "Why do you believe in Christian mythology?" The one Samaritan leper who comes back to Jesus to say thank you isn't supposed to be a good guy. The very category, "foreigner" is meant to be pejorative. Now, I can't be sure, if the student who was challenging Charlie was a foreigner, but he very well might have been. But whether he was an American citizen or someone from a different nation, his question reveals a different kind of outsider status. I'm referring to the fact that this student was definitely an outsider to the faith of Christians. His question revealed the ancient pagan world view. All religions are myths. To Charlie's great credit, he answered the student with reason and charity and tact. A point Charlie made was that no one in the first century would have started a movement as radical as Christianity by basing the evidence of Christ's resurrection on the word of a few women who said they met the risen Lord. It makes no sense. But this is the important point of seeing the difference between Christianity and paganism. If religions can be considered mythology, then making sense, or being reasonable doesn't matter. For example, the evidence that Apollo exists is pointing out that the sun races across the sky. If the sun races across the sky, then there must be a god who pulls it in a chariot. Does that make sense to you? I didn't think so. And I don't think it made much sense to the followers of Apollo either, but follow him they did. Why? I don't know. But there must have been other reasons, like follow Apollo or else lose your job or even your head.

I can't help sharing yet another precious thought from G.K. Chesterton on religious belief. In *The Everlasting Man*, he tells us there is a great difference between the knowledge gained through the modern methods of "science"-that is, through the methods of experimentations,-and the knowledge gained through the everlasting methods of collecting evidence of ALL kinds, scientific experiments as well as the overpowering evidence from "credible witnesses." The skeptical student who challenged Charlie, I am sure, was taught that he should only accept proof that comes from "scientific experiments." I do feel sorry for such people because they will never believe anyone who tells them, "I love you," because love is proven, not in a laboratory, but more like what Cher sang, when she said, "it's in his kiss."


Next weekend we celebrate World Mission Sunday and our fundamental

The Epoch Times (informacyjna sieć internetowa) powtórzyła wywiad, który Charlie Kirk przeprowadził ze studentem. Pytanie studenta brzmiało: „Dlaczego wierzasz w chrześcijańską mitologię?” Ten jeden Samarytanin-trędowaty, który wraca do Jezusa, aby Mu podziękować, nie miał być „dobrym bohaterem”. Samo określenie „cudzoziemiec” miało wydźwięk pejoratywny. Nie wiem, czy ten student, który prowokował Charliego, był cudzoziemcem. Niezależnie od tego, czy był obywatelem amerykańskim, czy przybyszem z innego kraju, jego pytanie ujawniło jednak inny rodzaj statusu osoby z zewnątrz. Mianowicie chodzi o to, że ten student był zdecydowanie obcy wobec wiary chrześcijan. Jego pytanie ujawniło starożytny pogański światopogląd: wszystkie religie to mity. Dzięki Charliemu, należy przyznać, że odpowiedział z rozsądkiem, życzliwością i taktem. Zwrócił uwagę m.in., że nikt w I wieku nie rozpoczęłby tak radykalnego ruchu jak chrześcijaństwo, opierając dowód zmartwychwstania Chrystusa na świadectwie kilku kobiet, które twierdzili, że spotkały Zmartwychwstałego Pana. To przecież nie miało sensu. Ale właśnie w tym tkwi różnica między chrześcijaństwem a pogaństwem. Jeśli religie traktuje się jak mitologię, wtedy nie ma znaczenia ani logika, ani rozsądek. Na przykład dowód na istnienie Apolla polegał na tym, że słońce „pędzi” po niebie. A skoro słońce pędzi po niebie, to musi istnieć bóg, który ciągnie je rydwanem. Czy to ma sens dla ciebie? Ja też tak nie sądzę. Przyznam również, że nawet dla wyznawców Apolla nie miało to większego sensu, a jednak za nim szli. Dlaczego? Nie wiem. Ale musiały istnieć inne powody, np. – czcij Apolla, albo stracisz pracę, a może nawet głowę.

Nie mogę się również oprzeć, by nie podzielić się jeszcze jedną cenną myślą G.K. Chestertona na temat naszej wiary. W książce pt. Wieczny Człowiek (The Everlasting Man) pisze on, że istnieje ogromna różnica między wiedzą zdobytą metodami współczesnej „nauki”, czyli eksperymentami, a wiedzą zdobytą wiecznymi metodami zbierania wszelkiego rodzaju dowodów – zarówno naukowych eksperymentów, jak i przytaczającego świadectwa wiarygodnych świadków. Sceptyczny student, który kwestionował Charliego, był z pewnością uczyony, że powinien przyjmować tylko takie dowody, które pochodzą z „eksperymentów naukowych”. Szczerze wspieram takim ludziom, bo nigdy nie uwierzą nikomu, kto powie im: „Kocham Cię.” Bo przecież miłość nie jest udowadniana w laboratorium, lecz – jak śpiewała Cher – „jest w jego pocztku.”




