**Dear Parishioners,**

In today's Gospel, Jesus left His native Nazareth - the city where He was raised. Then He went to Capernaum - a city chosen by Jesus that He loved, which became His home. He settled in Galilee, in what was considered to be the land of the Gentiles in His day. People who lived in Galilee adopted some of the Greek customs, partially forgetting Jewish ones. Today's Gospel also shows this by calling the first apostles: Simon and his brother Andrew. Both names have Greek origin. Influences of Hellenic culture also crept into other daily habits, gradually taken over from the Gentiles.

For His city, Jesus chose a place where there were many people lost in life and unsure of where they were going. They stumbled into the darkness. Jesus came with the light - with the words of the Gospel, the Good News: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is coming." Jesus who came and settled in Galilee, the city of Gentiles, is the one who with His arrival brought the Kingdom of God, which, like visible rays of the sun, overcomes darkness.

Jesus does not abandon us; He comes and wants to be among us in our everyday lives. Jesus wants to be present everywhere, not only in those areas where it is nice and pleasant in our lives. Jesus wants to come and light the light of His presence everywhere in our lives; in our everyday difficulties, even in the dark, damp, cluttered basement, which we may be ashamed of. He wants to be a part of everything that is problematic and sinful. He wants to help us get out of it; He wants to help us organize it. He wants to bring light into our lives, without which there is no real life. Let us invite Jesus to help us, allow Him to light His light in our lives.




