From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners,

In the spirit of Ascension Thursday/ Sunday, and Mother's Day I share a rather odd source: Pope Leo XIII's Encyclical On the Nature of True Liberty (Libertas

Praestantissimum). Pope Leo wrote this way back in 1888, just 27 years after Italy became a Kingdom, 23 years after our Civil War. He felt the powerful need to teach the world one main truth, namely there is a big difference between what the world calls "freedom" and what faith in God calls "freedom".

Freedom seems to be a fine topic as we consider Our Lord ascending to heaven because our worldly existence imposes a multitude of limitations upon us. Full disclosure, one of my favorite things to say to myself when life throws me problems is "Why is life so complicated?" Even when I'm fumbling for my keys with my arms full, I tell myself, "I can't wait to get to heaven because I know we won't need keys there." So, the Ascension teaches us, as the Apostles learned back then, that we will be freer in heaven than we can ever be on earth. The Apostles were freer Apostles since they were unleashed as it were, to go to the ends of the earth and preach in His name.

Freedom is also wonderful to consider on Mother's Day because it's a day we typically free moms from their motherly jobs. It's great to free them from cooking and laundry, though we know they also have the much more important role of parent who is constantly training her children like Jesus trained his apostles and preparing to set her children free to live the faith on their own. Many young couples are afraid to have children as they consider children an obstacle to their own freedom. Every child should at some point in their lives see the great gifts that their mother has bestowed upon them. Every mother, with Our Father's grace, can see her motherly work as a supreme opportunity to be the person she is called to be.

So, what did Pope Leo say that is important to apostles, mothers and children alike? As Italy endured over a century of rebellions, wars and turmoil, and as millions of people were flocking to America because it stood as a beacon of freedom, he issued a teaching for mothers, children, kings and presidents. For all of us today, unless we really understand this lesson, all our attempts to bring

peace and prosperity to our families, our nation and our hearts will reflect the futility of rearranging the chairs on the deck of the Titanic. He made the connection between true freedom and Our Lord's instructions. Our Father gave us freedom so that we can love one another in the spirit of truth. His words are almost haunting, but alas, ultimately, they are freeing. He said, "Many there are who follow in the footsteps of Lucifer and adopt as their own his rebellious cry, "I will not serve," and consequently substitute for true liberty what is sheer and most foolish license."



Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie,

W duchu Uroczystości Wniebowstąpienia Pańskiego w czwartek/niedziele oraz z okazji Dnia Matki, pragnę podzielić się z Wami dość nietypowym źródłem: Encykliką papieża Leona XIII pt. "O Naturze Prawdziwej Wolności"

(Libertas Praestantissimum). Papież Leon napisał to już w odległym 1888 roku i zaledwie 27 lat po tym, jak Włochy stały się Królestwem, oraz 23 lata po naszej Wojnie Domowej. Uważał, że istnieje silna potrzeba nauczania świata jednej głównej prawdy, mianowicie podkreslił dużą różnicę między tym, co świat nazywa "wolnością", a tym, co wiara w Boga nazywa "wolnością".

Wolność wydaje się być na dzisiaj doskonałym tematem rozważając Wniebowstąpienie naszego Pana, ponieważ nasze ziemskie istnienie nakłada na nas mnóstwo ograniczeń. Szczerze, jedną z moich ulubionych rzeczy do powiedzenia sobie, gdy życie rzuca mi kłody pod nogi, jest pytanie "Dlaczego życie musi być tak skomplikowane?" Nawet gdy czasem próbuję unieść więcej na swych barkach niż mogę, to mówię sobie: "Nie mogę się doczekać nieba, bo wiem, że tam już nie będzie tych wszystkich problemów." Tak więc Wniebowstąpienie uczy nas, jak Apostołowie poznali, że będziemy wolniejsi w niebie, niż kiedykolwiek możemy być na ziemi. Apostołowie mieli ten przywilej, ponieważ zostali wybrani, aby iść na krańce ziemi i głosić imię Pana.

Wolność jest również wspaniałym tematem do rozważenia w Dniu Matki. Jest to dzień, w którym uwalniamy nasze mamy od ich macierzyńskich obowiązków. Wspaniale jest wyręczyć je z obowiązków gotowania czy prania, choć wiemy, że mają one również o wiele ważniejszą rolę rodzica, który nieustannie wychowuje swoje dzieci i przygotowuje je do życia w wierze, tak jak Jezus wychowywał kiedyś swoich apostołów. Wielu młodych par boi się założyć rodzinę uważając dzieci za przeszkodę do własnej wolności. Każde dziecko powinno w pewnym momencie swojego życia dostrzec wielkie dary, które matka im ofiarowała. Każda matka, przy łasce Naszego Ojca, może spojrzeć na swoją macierzyńską pracę jako osobę do której jest powołana.

A więc co powiedział papież Leon, co było ważne zarówno dla apostołów, matek, jak i dzieci? W czasie gdy Włochy przetrwały przez ponad wiek wiele buntów, wojen i niepokojów, a miliony ludzi migrowały do Ameryki, która stała się symbolem wolności. Wtedy wydał nauczanie dla matek, dzieci, królów i prezydentów. Dla wszystkich nas dzisiaj, o ile naprawdę nie zrozumiemy tej lekcji, wszystkie nasze próby przynoszenia pokoju i dobrobytu naszym rodzinom, naszemu narodowi i naszym sercom bedą

odzwierciedlać daremność przestawiania krzeseł na pokładzie Titanika. Papież Leon ustanowił związek między prawdziwą wolnością a naukami naszego Pana. Nasz Ojciec dał nam wolność, abyśmy mogli miłować się nawzajem w duchu prawdy. Jego słowa są niemal przerażające, ale w końcu są też wyzwalające. Powiedział: "Wielu jest tych, którzy podążają śladami Lucyfera i przyjmują na własność jego buntowniczy krzyk: 'Nie będę służył'. Zastępują prawdziwą wolność tym, co jest czystą i najbardziej głupią swawolą."


